



About the Clemency Initiative

The New Jersey Constitution gives the Governor the power to grant clemency to individuals who have been convicted of a crime under state law. Clemency could mean that a person receives a pardon or that their criminal sentence is commuted so that it is less severe.

On June 19, 2024, Governor Phil Murphy issued [Executive Order No. 362](#) which explains how the Governor will consider clemency applications for the rest of the Murphy Administration. Under the Executive Order, each clemency application will receive individualized consideration, but certain categories of clemency applications are prioritized and expedited for consideration. The Governor also has established the Clemency Advisory Board to evaluate each clemency application and recommend whether it should be granted. [Read more about the Clemency Advisory Board here](#).

Apply for a Pardon or Commutation

At this time, and through the end of the Administration, we are accepting clemency applications for both potential pardons and commutations of sentence. Though not all applications will be expedited (see the 'FAQ' page), anyone can apply, and will receive careful and thorough consideration.

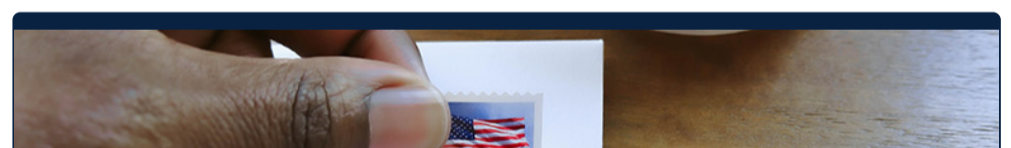


Apply Online
