Purpose for Which Funds will be Used: The mission of the YTTW program is to recruit, screen and facilitate effective transitions of high school juniors, seniors and out-of-school youth to high-skill, high-wage employment in labor demand occupations, with long-term career potential and opportunities for occupationally relevant lifelong learning, thereby motivating youth to greater success in secondary and post-secondary education.

Entities That Can Apply for Funding Under This NGO: This targeted opportunity is available only to current FY2023 YTTW grant recipients. If you are not a current FY2023 YTTW grantee you are not eligible to apply. Those eligible to apply for FY2024 funding must be one of the following:

- Any employer or business;
- Any labor organization which represents workers in the occupation for which the apprentices will be trained;
- Public high schools within New Jersey;
- Public vocational schools within New Jersey;

- Two- and four-year institutions of higher education;
- Public or private non-profit agencies;
- Business or trade organizations representing a particular trade, group of trades, contractors or employers;
- Community-based organizations; and
- Faith-based organizations.
