To the Honorable Senate and General Assembly of New Jersey:

The statute of New Jersey declares that the Librarian shall, in the month of January, annually, report to the Legislature a full and complete statement of the Library; and accordingly the following is respectfully submitted:

REPORT OF STATE LIBRARIAN.

Nothing of importance occurs at any time during the year that would give especial interest to one report over another. The business operations of the Library are rather monotonous, and to give a plain, full statement of its transactions is about all it will afford.

RULES OF THE STATE LIBRARY.

Hours.

The Library is kept open from 9 o'clock A. M. until 1 o'clock P. M., and from 2 until 6 o'clock P. M.

Regulations.

Those who are entitled to take out books are, by law, members and officers and ex-members of the Legislature, officers of the Executive Department of the State Government, Judges of the District and Circuit Court of the United States, District Attorney, Chancellor, Judges of the Supreme Court, and Court of Errors and Appeals of this State, Adjutant and Quartermaster Generals, Attorneys of Supreme Court.

Restrictions.

1. No persons, except such as are privileged so to do by the statute regulating the State Library, shall be permitted to take out any book, unless he shall have a permit in writing from any of the persons privileged as aforesaid by the said statute.
2. That no person shall give more than two permits, with the exception of the Library Commissioners, each of whom shall be authorized to give ten, and which permits, upon presentation, shall be filed by the Librarian, and shall be good for one year from their date.
3. That no person by virtue of a permit, shall be entitled to take out more than one volume at a time, unless such volume be one of a series; in such case two may be simultaneously taken.
