Aviation Department - Traffic Statistics

Aviation Department

The 100 million revenue passenger mark was within grasp for the region, with total traffic finishing the year at 99.8 million. But escaped when Hurricane Wilma pounded Florida in October. December total passenger volume was up 3.4 percent, and year-end was up 6.3 percent.
