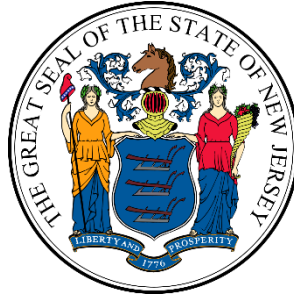

SUBJECT: State Fiscal Year 2019 (FY2019) 2nd Amended Interim Transportation Financing Program Project Priority List

The New Jersey Infrastructure Bank (the “I-Bank” or “NJIB”) and the New Jersey Department of Transportation (the “Department” or “DOT”), are pleased to present the 2nd Amended State Fiscal Year 2019 (“FY2019”) Interim Financing Program Project Priority List to the New Jersey State Legislature pursuant to the New Jersey Infrastructure Trust Act N.J.S.A. 58:11 B-1 et seq. (“the Act”). The I-Bank is obligated, pursuant to the Act, to publish the Transportation Infrastructure Bank Priority System (TIBPS) and Transportation Infrastructure Project Priority List (TIPPL) for the ensuing fiscal year.

The Act established the New Jersey Transportation Infrastructure Bank (the “Transportation Bank”) to make low interest loans for local transportation infrastructure projects with a mission of reducing the cost of financing for New Jersey counties and municipalities’ critical transportation projects. FY2019 is the Transportation Bank’s inaugural year as the operating funds were appropriated on January 16, 2018 pursuant to P.L.2017, c.327.

The FY2019 2nd Amended Interim Financing Program Project Priority List, set forth in Appendix A, consists of 26 projects with an estimated value of \$147.3 million. This Project Priority List is limited to projects for which Transportation Bank loan applications have been received in the first quarter of FY2019 (July 1, 2018 through September 30, 2018). The next (3rd Amended) Project Priority List reflecting loan applications received through the end of the second quarter of FY2019 (December 31, 2018), will be submitted January 2019.

The I-Bank and the Department are committed to developing the Transportation Bank as an effective vehicle to facilitate and reduce the cost of transportation projects throughout the State.

Thank you for your continued support of our Programs.
