January passenger activity was dominated by Winter Storm Grayson's negative impact as over 3,000 flights were cancelled and thousands more delayed as a result of the storm. For the first time since January 2014's 0.8 percent dip, we opened the year in negative territory as January traffic fell 2.6 percent (-254,341 passengers). The domestic sector led the decline as it fell by 4.9 percent (-306,114 passengers). On the other hand, international passenger traffic showed a 1.5 percent improvement (+51,773 passengers). Momentum from last year carried into 2017 as the region's total cargo traffic registered a solid 6.2 percent gain (+10,151 tons), despite Winter Storm Grayson. Domestic cargo activity, which accounts for 36 percent of the region's total volume, led the improvement with a 10.5 percent jump (+6,191 tons). International freight activity grew 3.7 percent (+3,960 tons).
