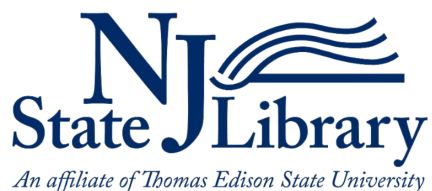

Introducing EDS (JerseyClicks One Search), a single search box that public libraries can implement anywhere on their website from which patrons will be able to immediately search all statewide databases, quickly access a specific database (MasterFile, NoveList, RefUSA) or even link directly to a specific magazine (Consumer Reports, Time, Sports

Illustrated). An intuitive and flexible way of quickly exposing patrons to premium content, increasing usage and user satisfaction. Additionally, the New Jersey State Library is providing a similar search tool direct to Consumer Reports, eliminating multiple clicks before patrons find information for which they are searching.
