

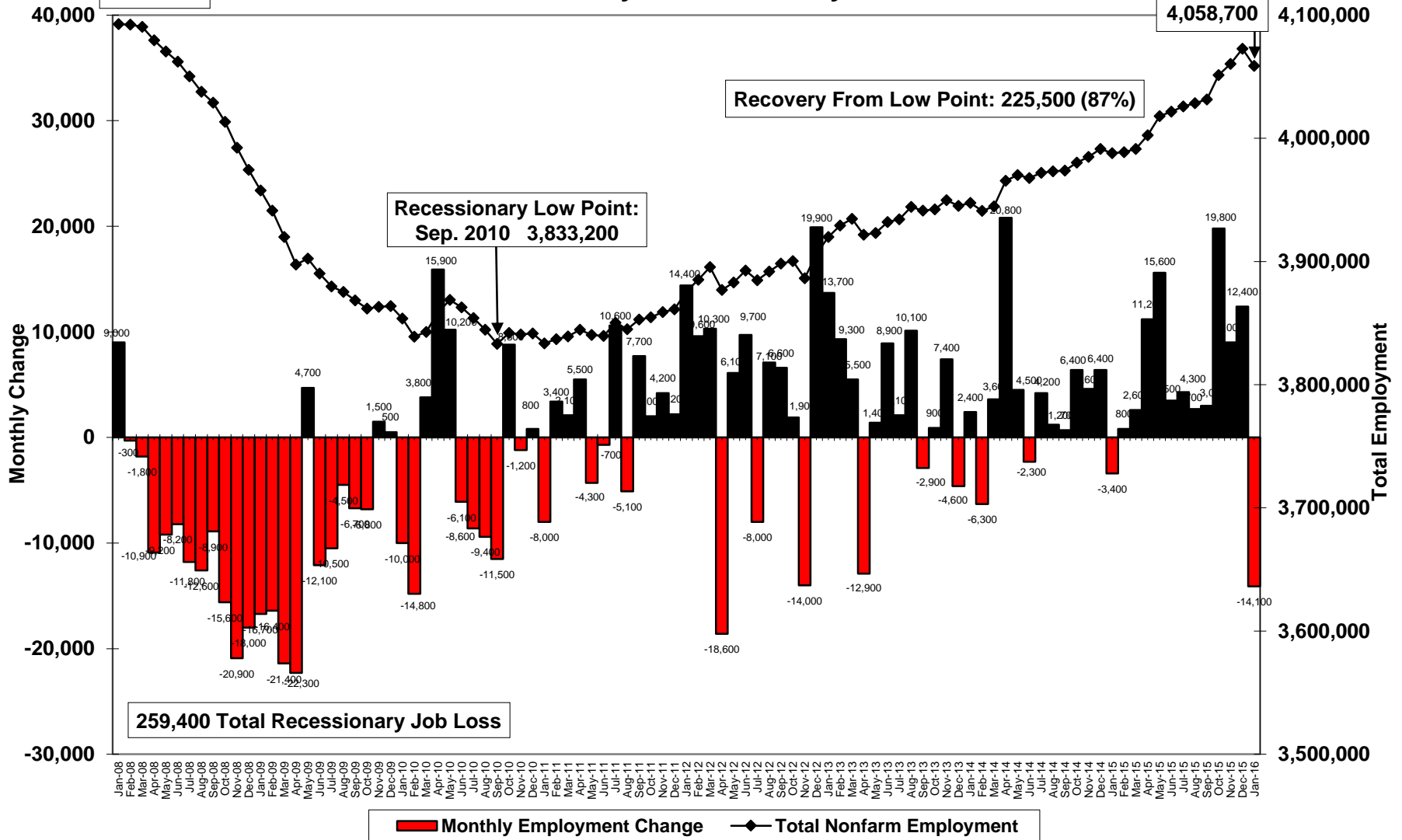

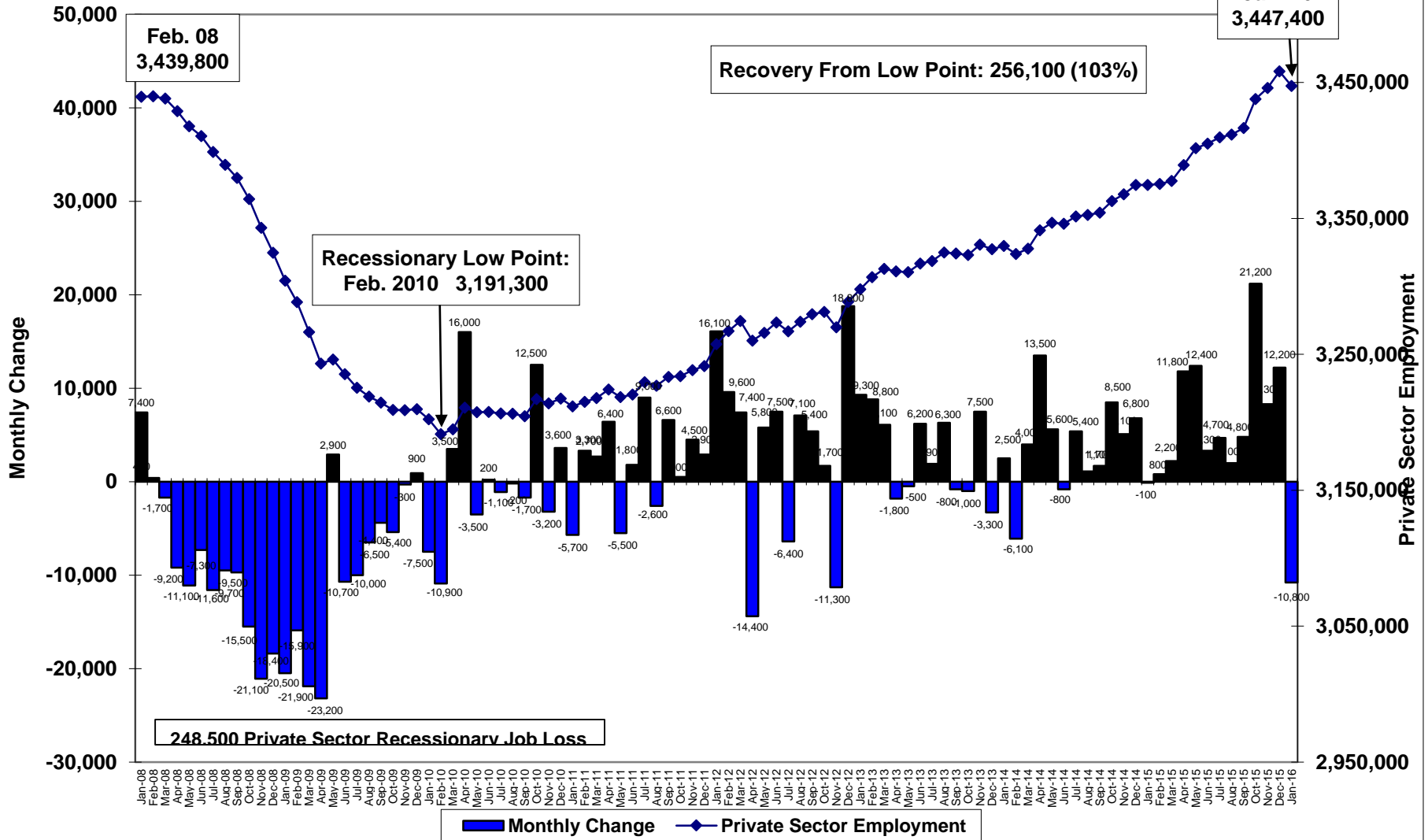

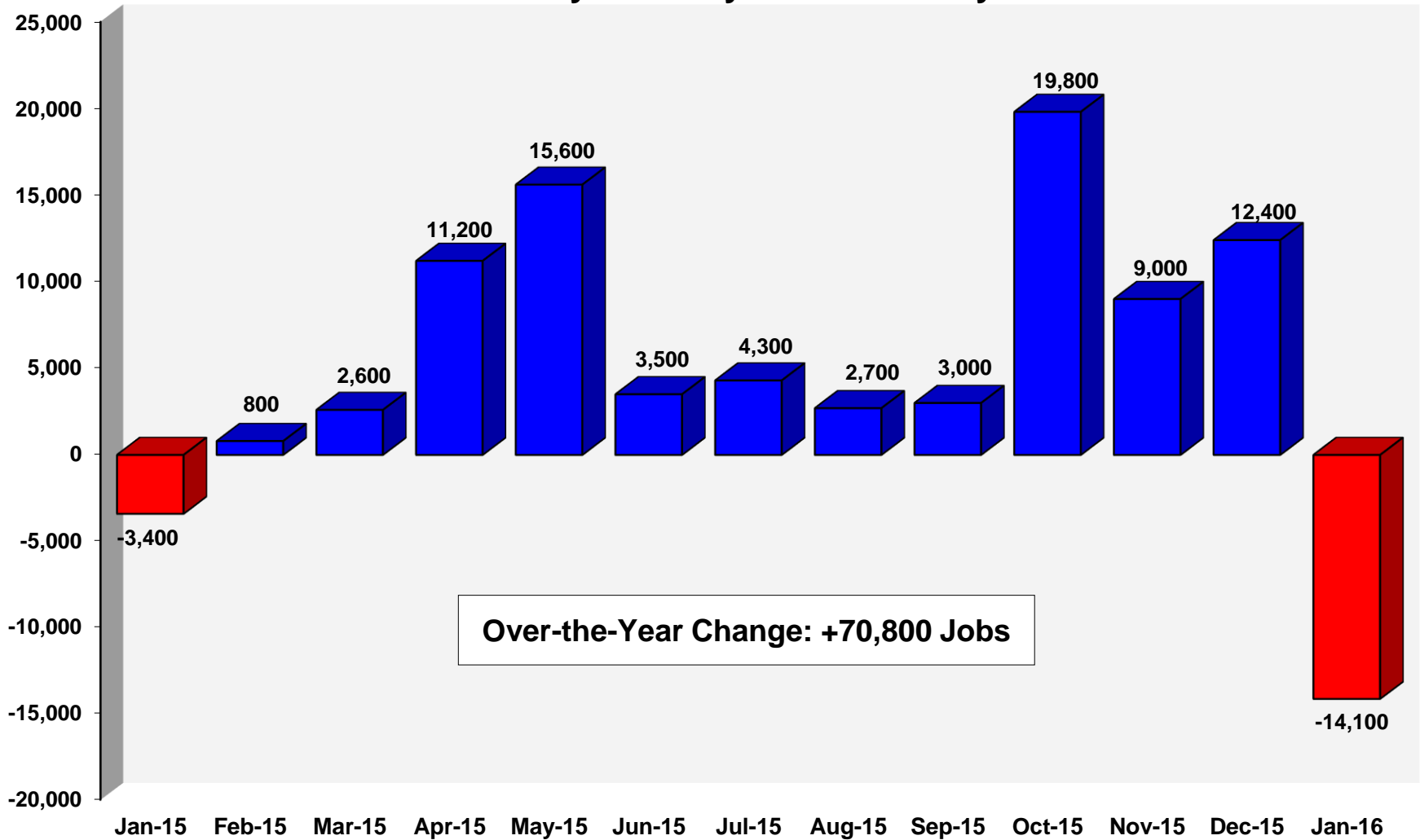
New Jersey Total Nonfarm Employment vs. Monthly Change January 2008 - January 2016



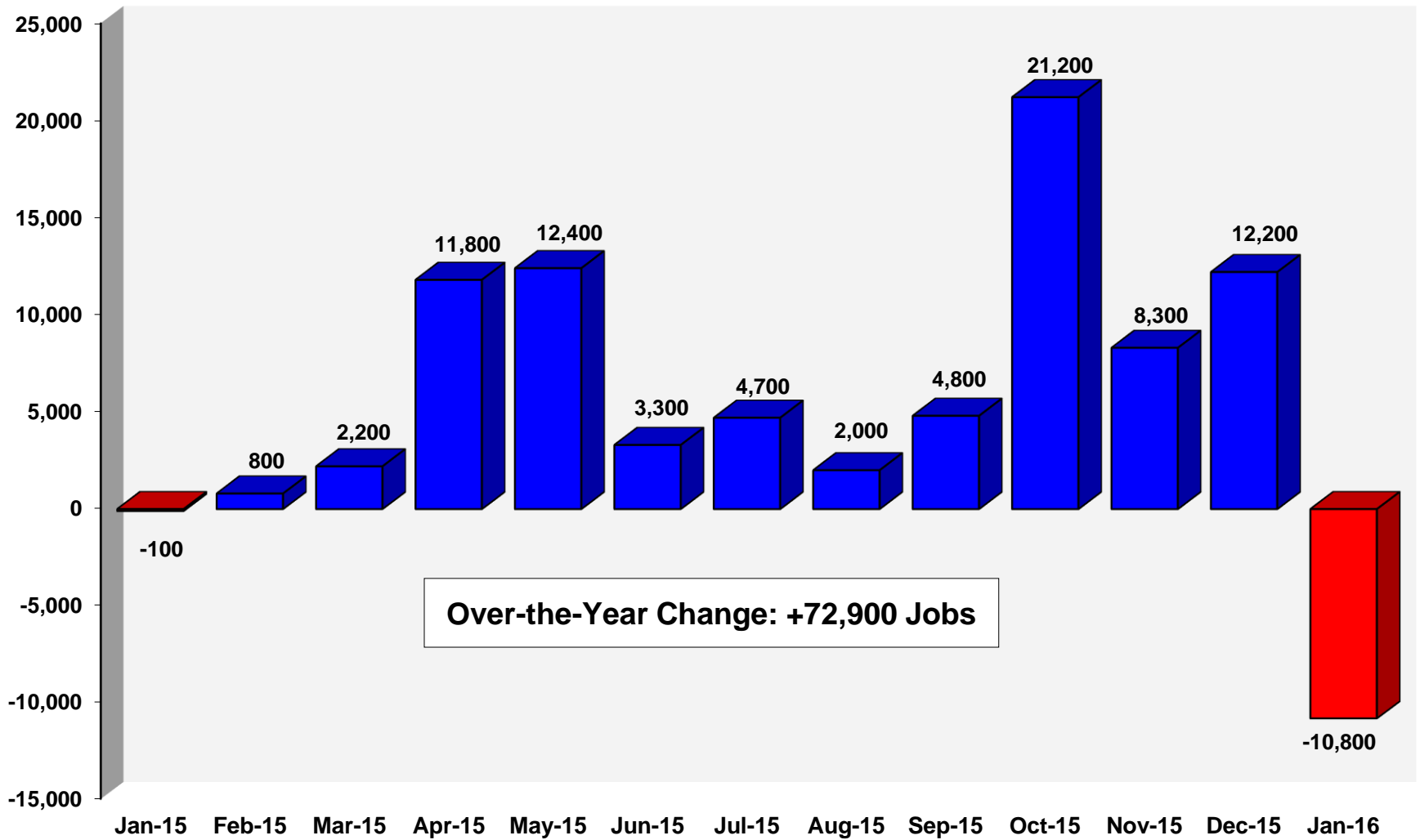
New Jersey Private Sector Employment vs. Monthly Change January 2008 - January 2016



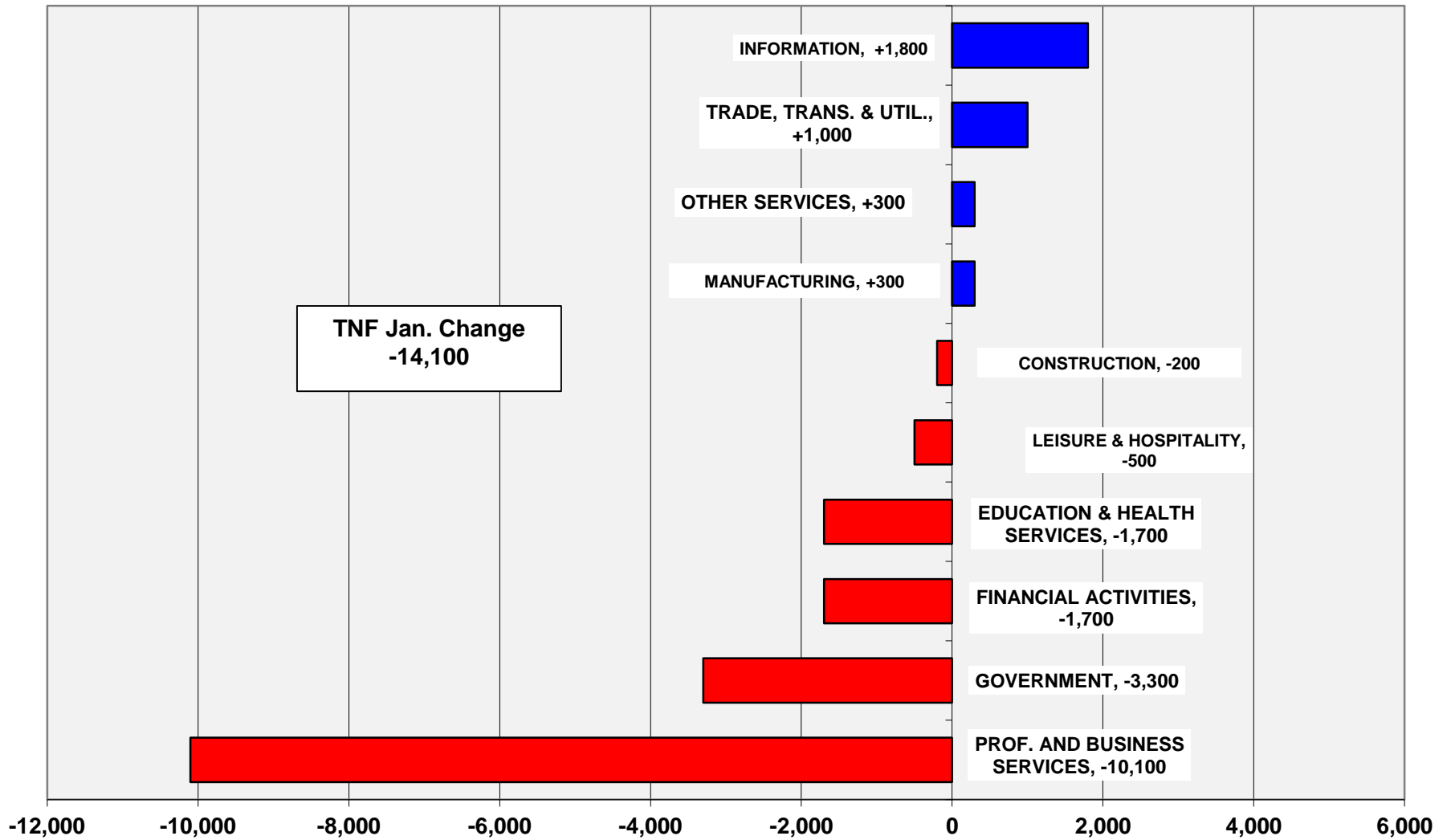
Monthly Total Employment Change New Jersey: January 2015 - January 2016



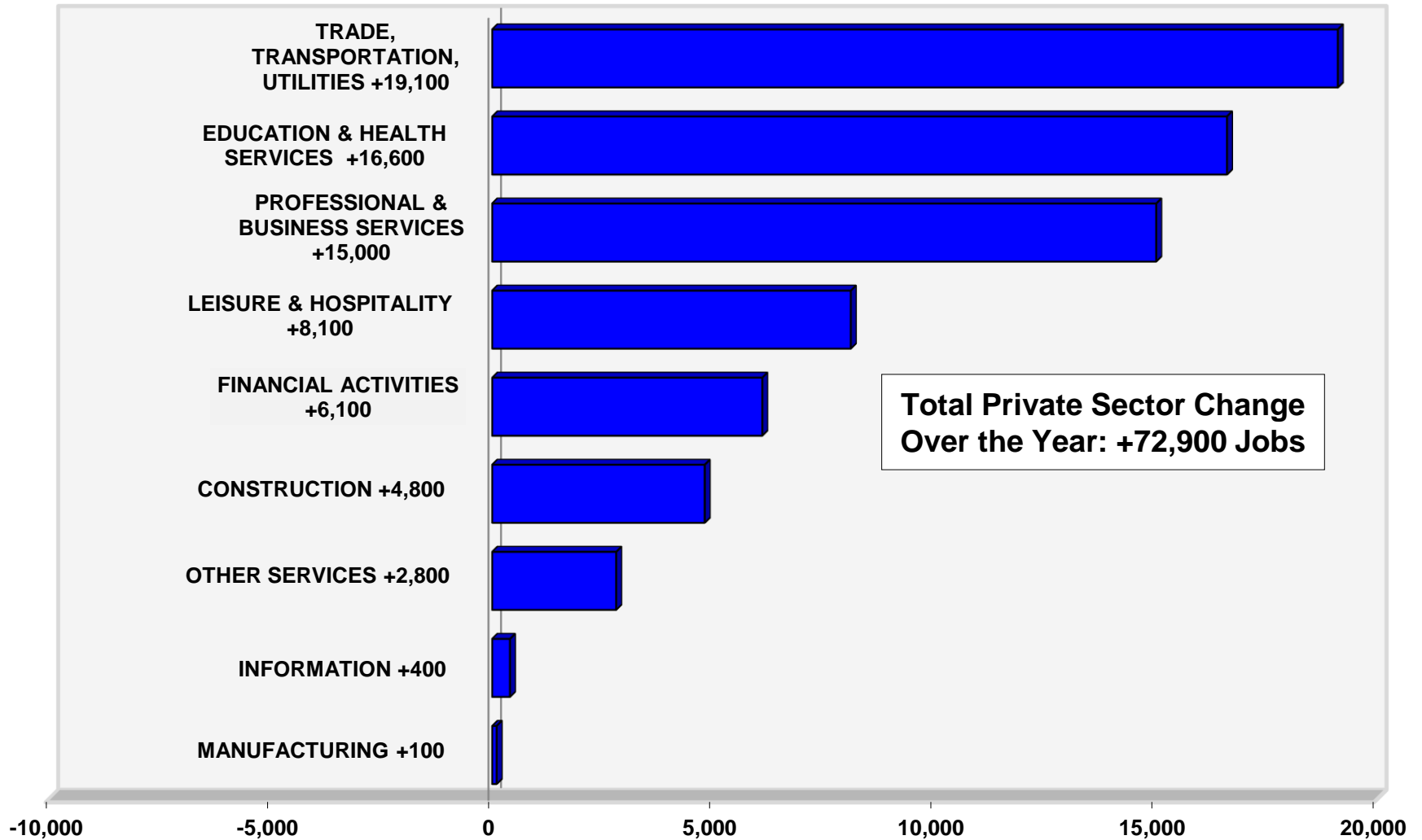
Monthly Private Sector Employment Change January 2015 - January 2016



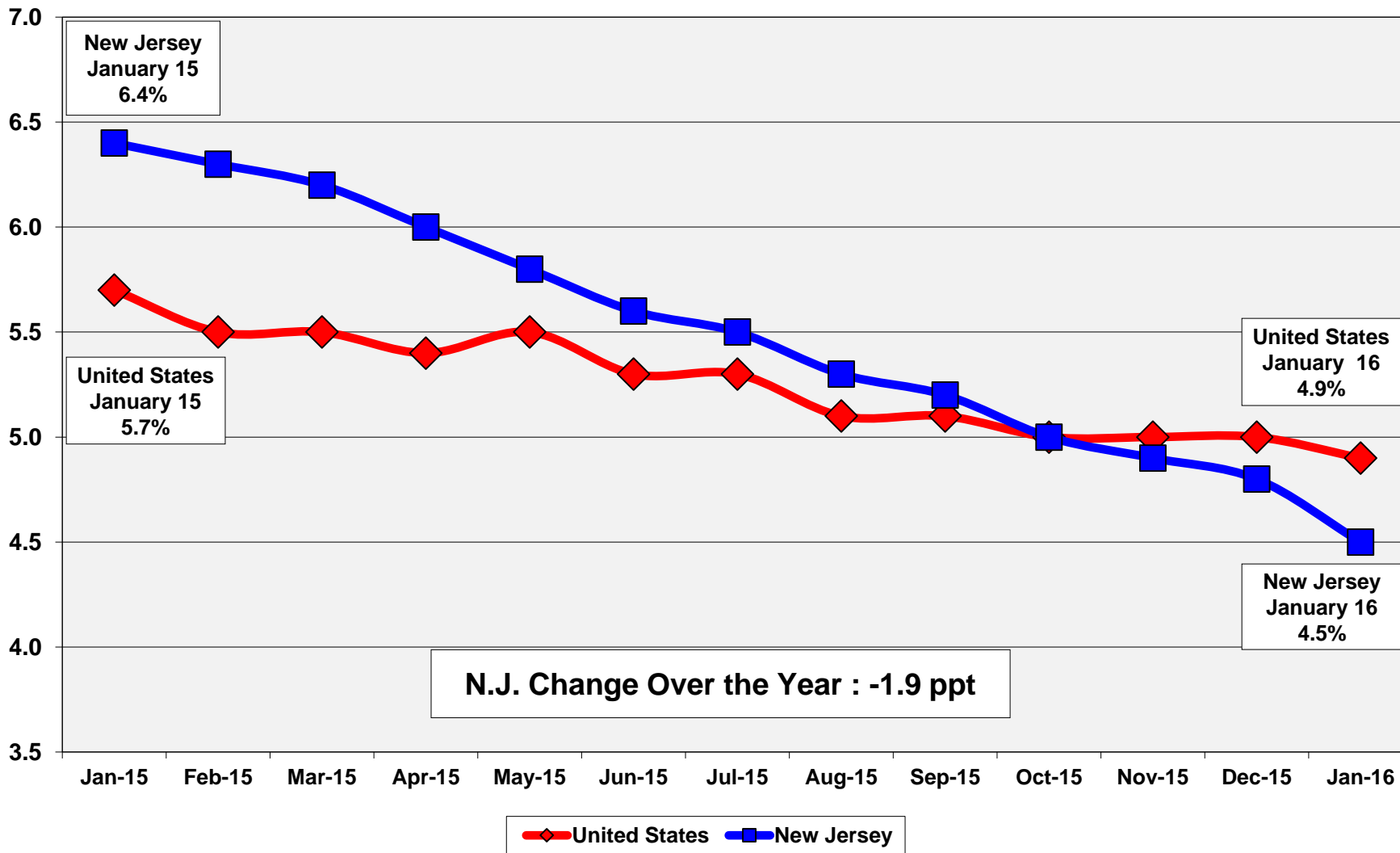

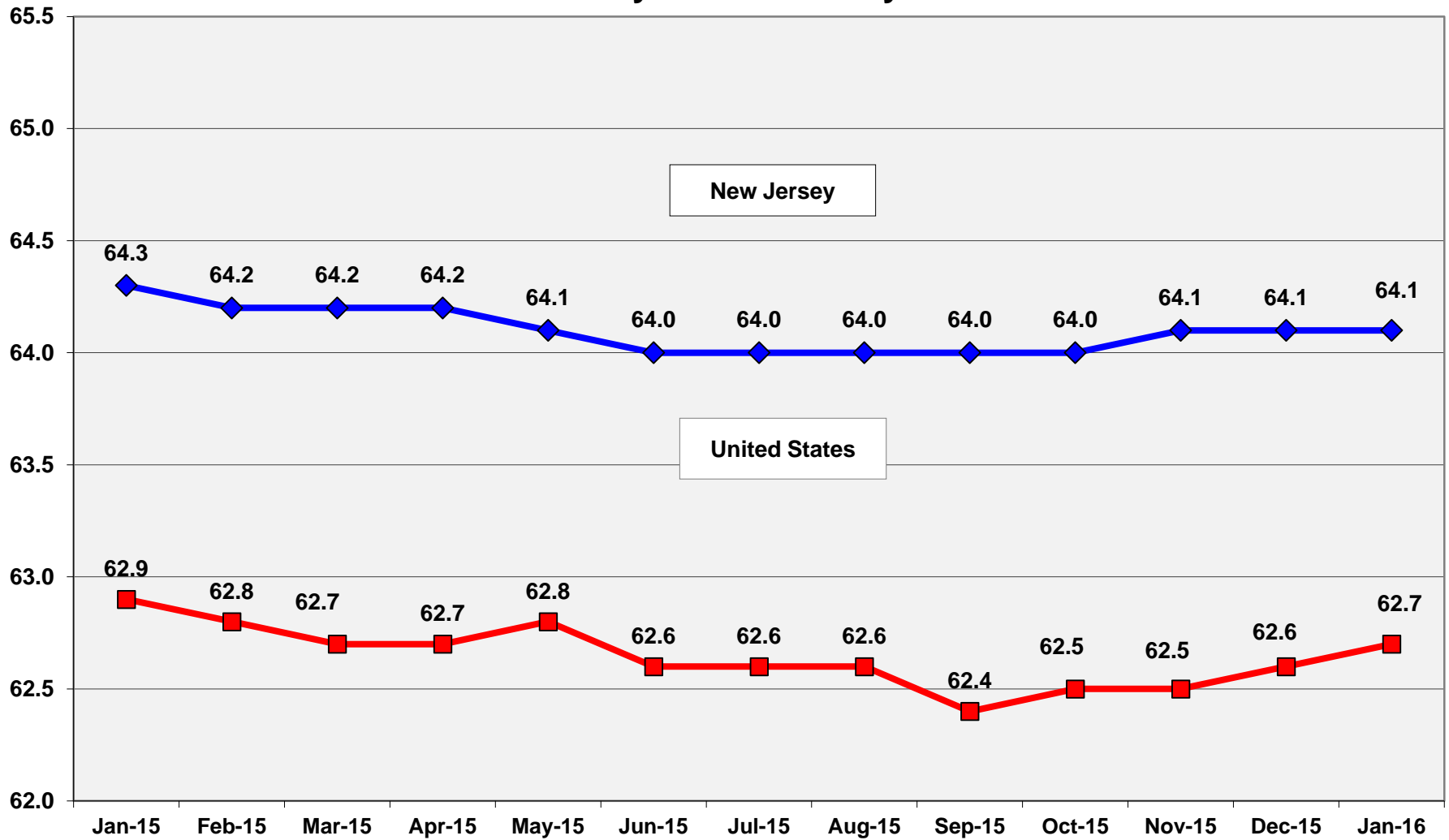
New Jersey Private Sector Employment Change by Industry January 2015 - January 2016



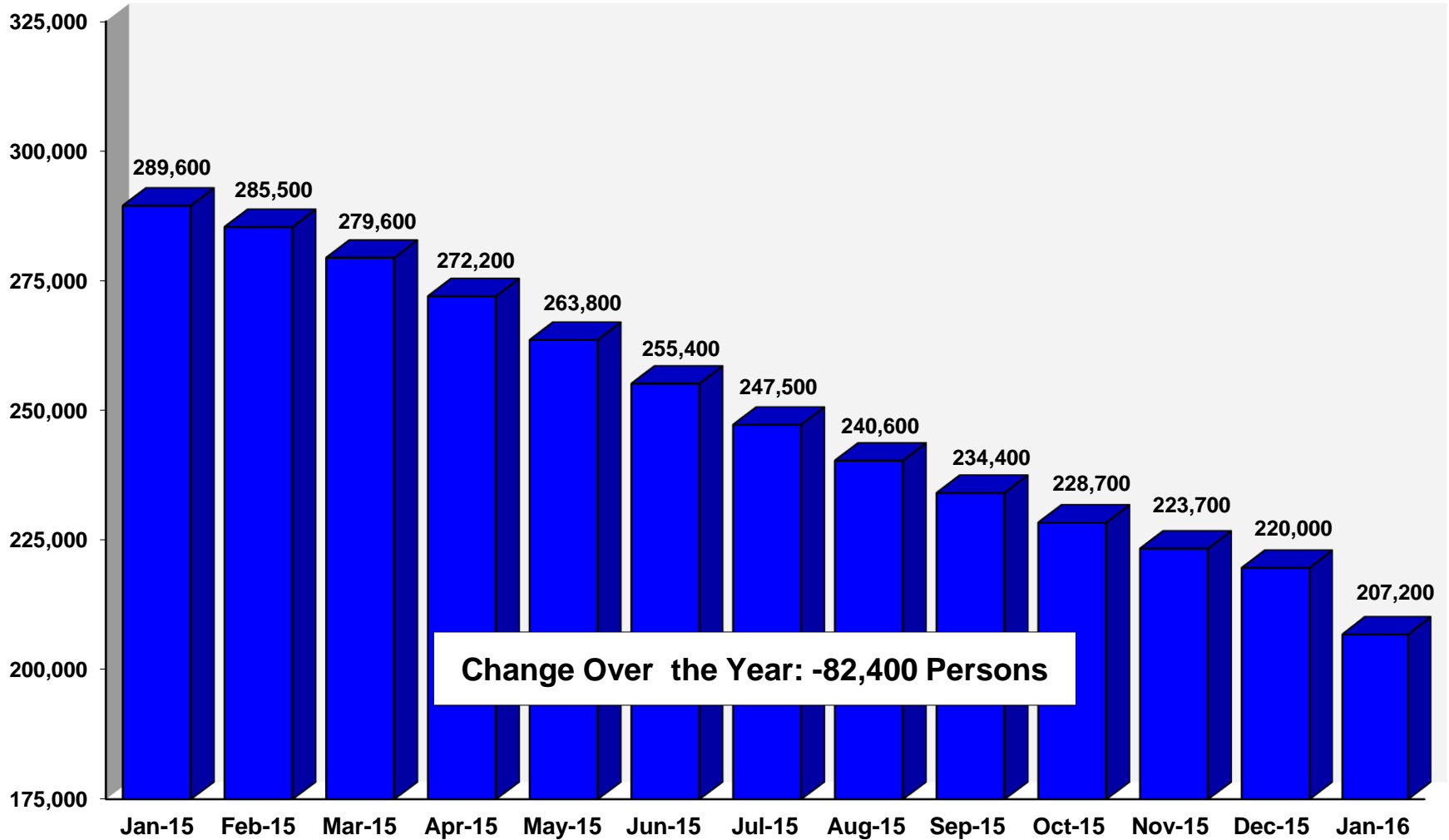
Unemployment Rates, New Jersey vs. United States: January 2015 - January 2016



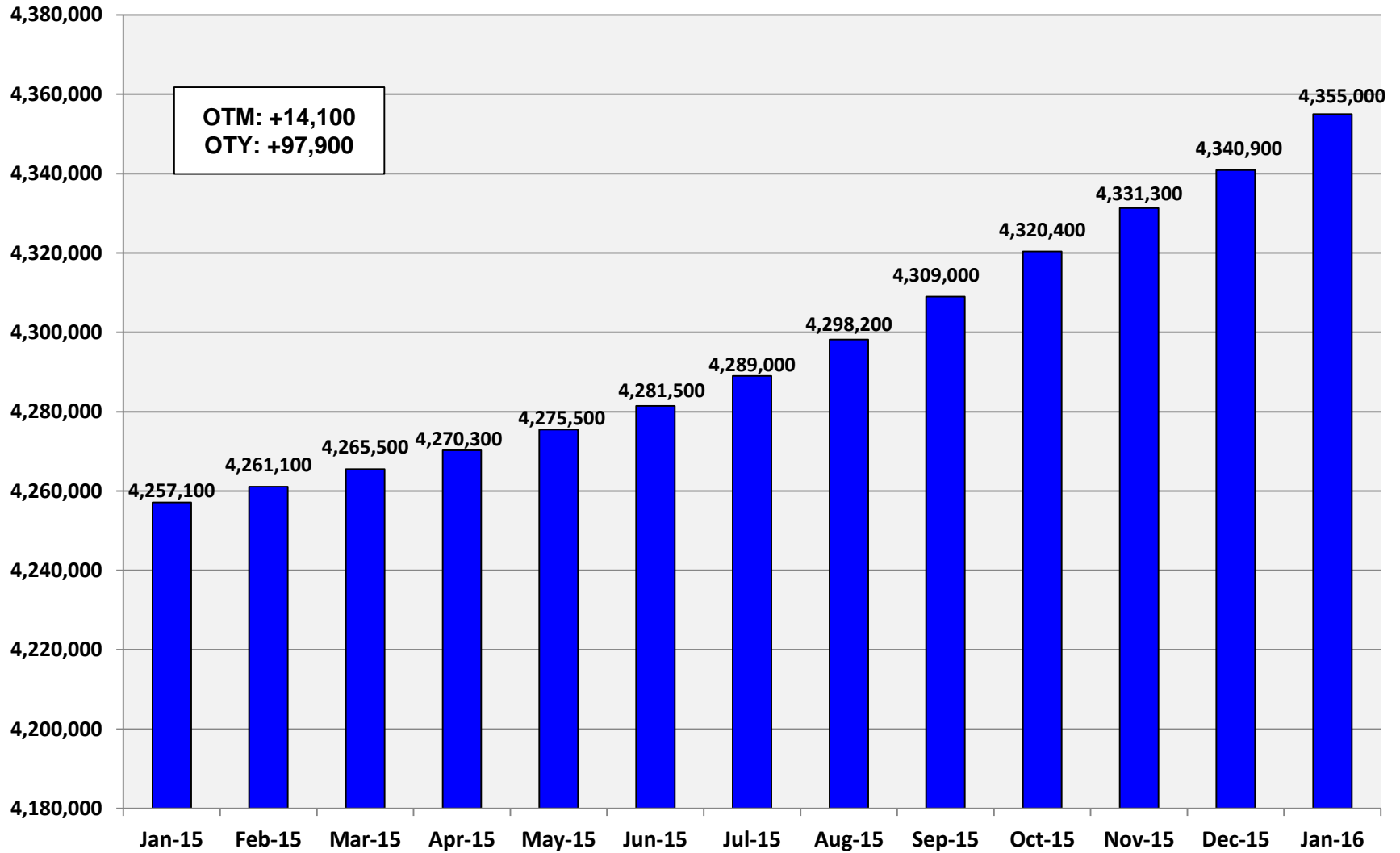
New Jersey vs. United States, Labor Force Participation Rate: January 2015 - January 2016



Unemployed New Jersey Residents January 2015 - January 2016

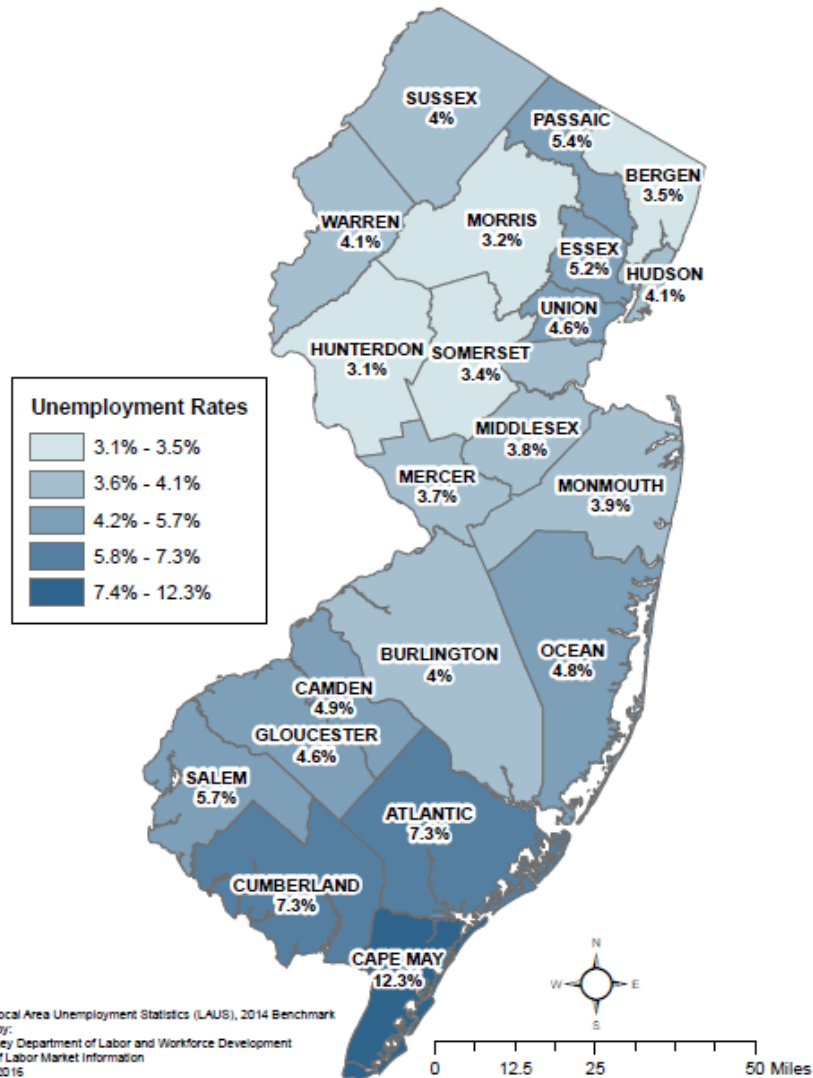


New Jersey Employed Residents: January 2015 - January 2016

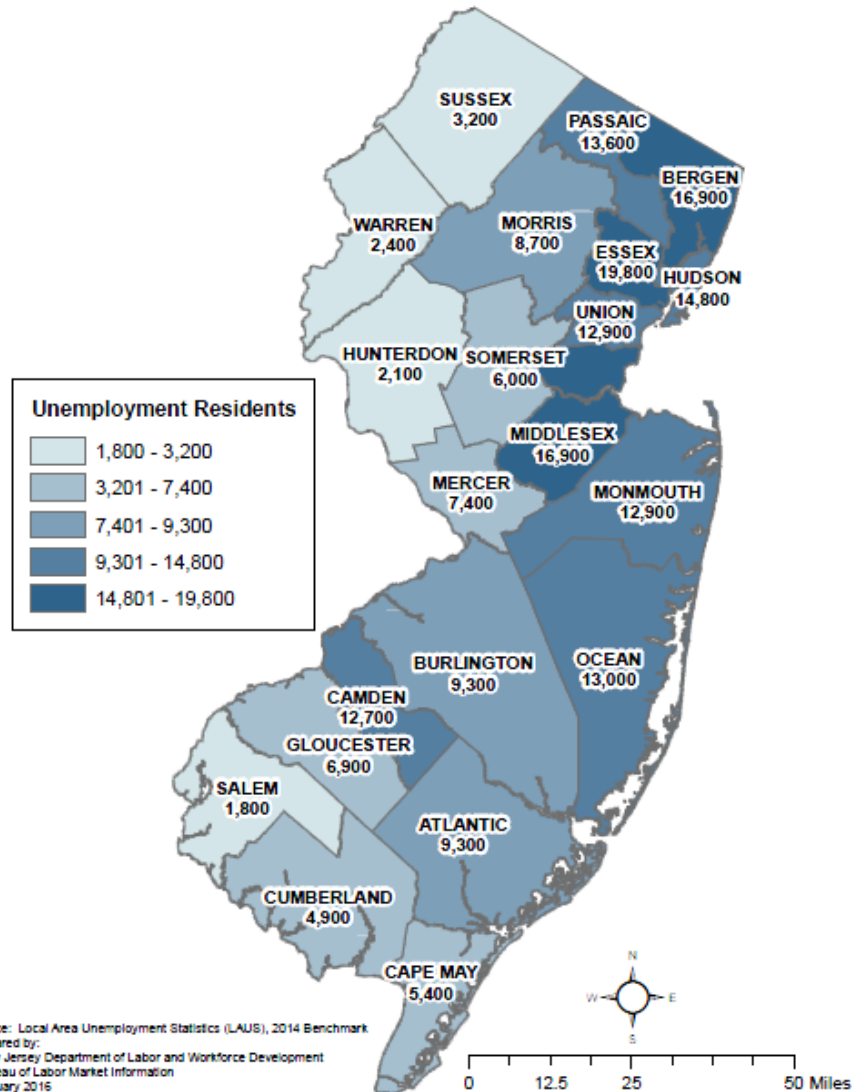

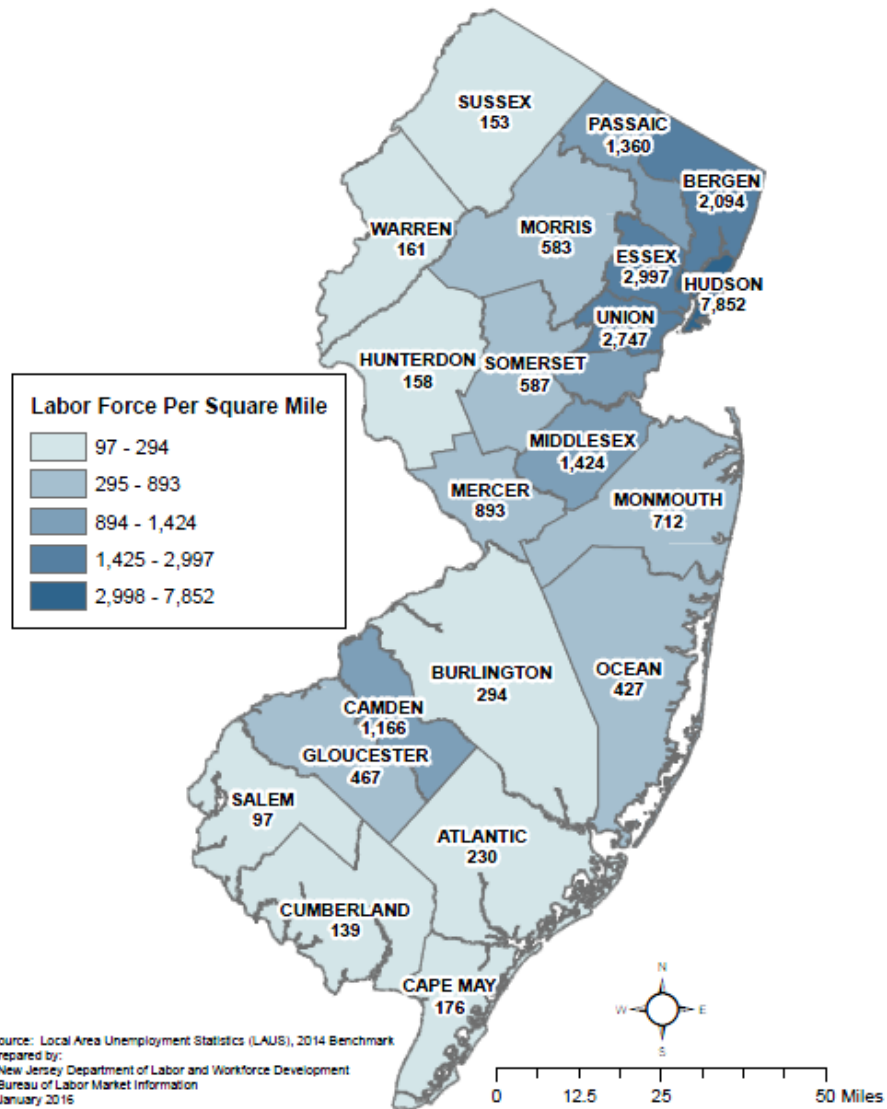
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New Jersey Counties

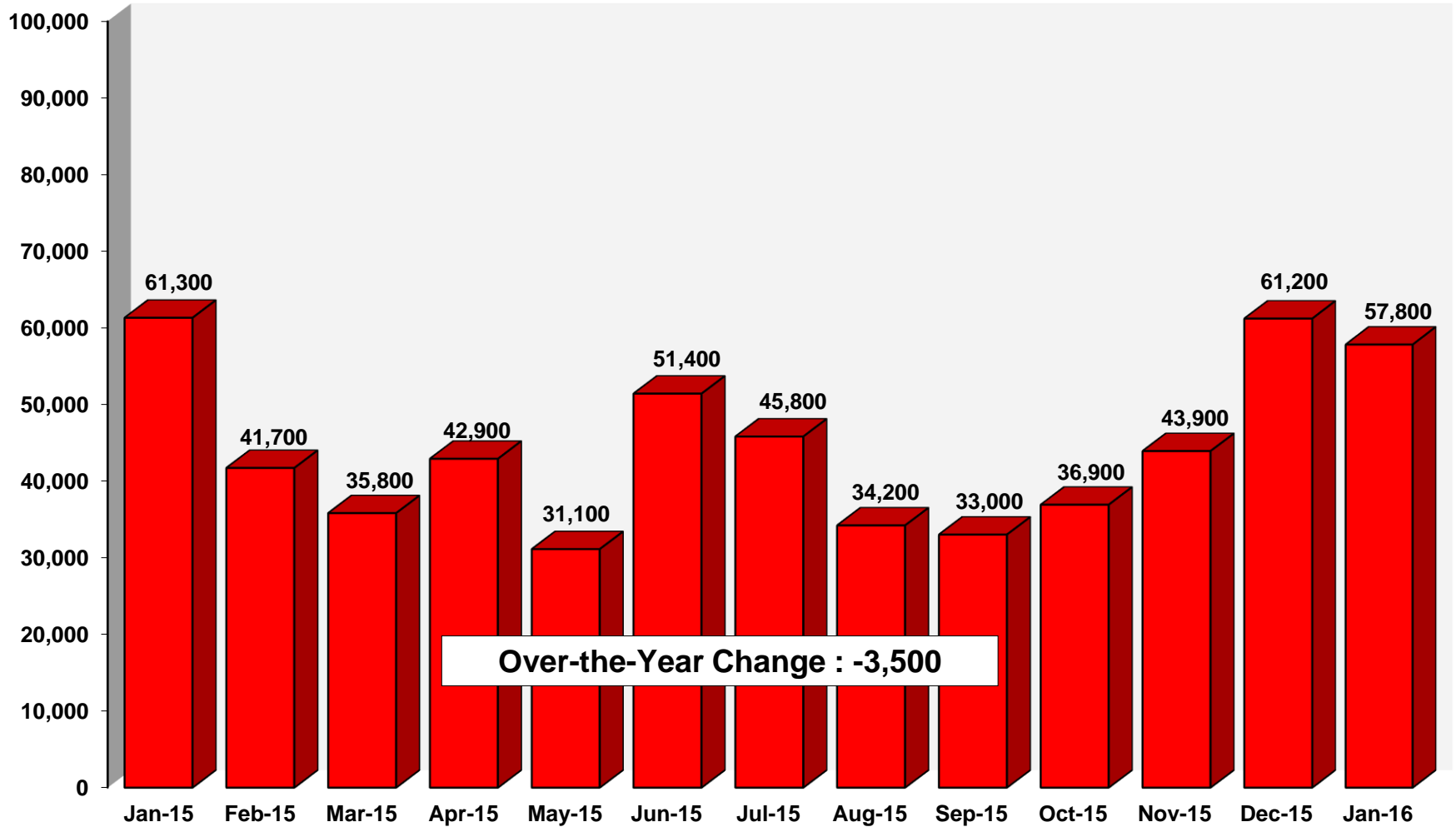
