RESIDENTS, ADMISSIONS AND RELEASES
JANUARY 1997

Comparing counts for January 31, 1997 with those on January 31, 1996, the following changes are noted:

RESIDENTS

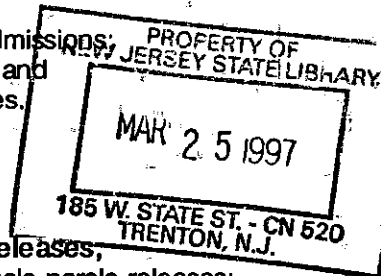
- 1% increase from 27,588 to 27,922 for all institutions;
- 1% increase from 26,795 to 27,104 for the adult jurisdictional population; (county waiting, county contract, county assistance, prison and youth complexes);
- -2% decrease from 4,517 to 4,416 for county waiting;
- -0% decrease from 1041 to 1036 for county contract and county assistance;
- 5% increase from 15,718 to 16,437 for the prison complex;
- -6% decrease from 5,519 to 5,215 for the youth facilities; and
- 3% increase from 793 to 818 for the juveniles (juvenile facilities and juvenile waiting).

ADMISSIONS

- 8% increase from 1,362 to 1,475 for total admissions;
- 6% increase from 1,303 to 1,375 for adults; and
- 69% increase from 59 to 100 for juveniles.

RELEASES

- 20% increase from 1,138 to 1,368 for total releases;
- 20% increase from 777 to 929 for adult male parole releases;
- 29% increase from 65 to 84 for adult female parole releases;
- 20% increase from 842 to 1,013 for total adult parole releases;
- 9% increase from 238 to 259 for offenders discharged at max; and
- 66% increase from 58 to 96 for juvenile releases.



NOTES: DEFINITIONS OF INMATES INCLUDED IN COUNTS

- a/ **RESIDENTS** include inmates in the institutions and on furlough on the last day of the reporting period. Past counts for major institutions may include the count for units that are no longer open. Housing security levels are designated as follows: SL I—community, SL II—minimum, SL III—medium, SL IV—maximum and SL V—close.
- b/ **ADMISSIONS** include commitments, parole returns for technical violation and prison and correctional returns from escape entered into the OBCIS database each month.
- c/ **DISCHARGE AT MAX** includes adult offenders released upon expiration of maximum sentence. Juvenile offenders are not included in this count.
