Unemployment claimants must verify their identity using the security vendor ID.me. You can also let us know if you suspect your identity has been compromised.

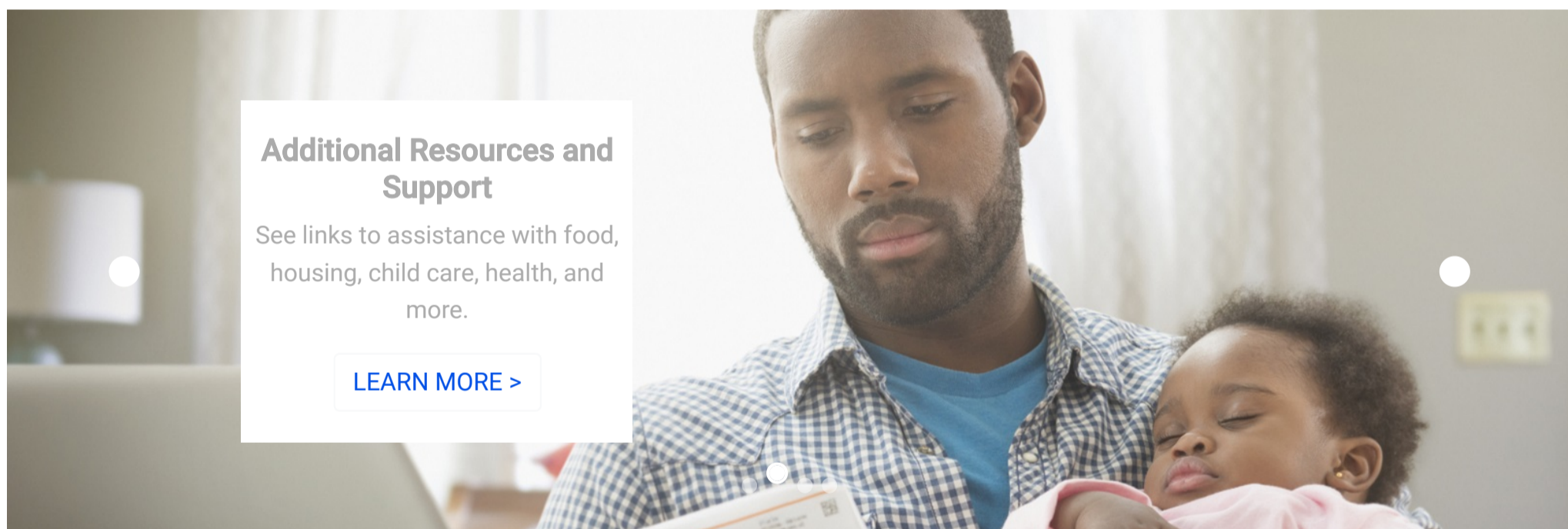
