Aviation Department - Traffic Statistics

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Notes1: The section entitled Air Transport Association Carriers is included to give a comparison between Port Authority Airport traffic growth and aggregate growth as measured by the majority of the U.S. carrier industry.

Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline ADI summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized. "Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

Aviation Department

As in the previous three months, the COVID-19 pandemic continued its devastating impact on the region's total, domestic and international air passenger traffic in the month of June. Total passenger volume posted a 91.9 percent year-over-year decline (-11.662 million passengers). As in the previous three months, the domestic sector (representing more than 60 percent of the region's total air passenger activity) accounted for the majority of the decline, handling 6.967 million fewer travelers (-88.7 percent). International passenger activity saw its volume plummet by 97 percent (down 4.695 million passengers). The region's total air cargo traffic continued its disappointing performance (-17.3 percent/-31,657 tons) as the international sectors recorded its fourth straight monthly double-digit plummet (-29.7 percent/-32,935 tons). Following 10 consecutive monthly drops, domestic freight traffic landed in positive territory with a 1.8 percent gain (+1,278 tons).
