Aviation Department - Traffic Statistics

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Notes1: The section entitled Air Transport Association Carriers is included to give a comparison between Port Authority Airport traffic growth and aggregate growth as measured by the majority of the U.S. carrier industry.

Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline ADI summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized."Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

Aviation Department
 The Port Authority's airports recorded the sharpest monthly decline in passenger volumes in their 70-plus-year history as the COVID-19 pandemic continued to pummel demand for air travel. April traffic fell 98.4 percent year-over-year, with the region handling only 190,647 passengers, down 11.661 million travelers from 2019. The domestic sector (representing over 60 percent of the region's total air traveler volume) accounted for the majority of the loss, handling only 144,140 travelers (down 7.469 million passengers/-98.1 percent from 2019). Airlines carried only 46,507 international passengers (down 4.191 million travelers/-98.9 percent). Total cargo traffic posted its 11th straight monthly fall (-35.7 percent/-63,107 tons). As in the previous 18 months, the international segment (representing nearly 60 percent of the region's total cargo activity) led the decline with a 51 percent plunge (-55,171 tons). Domestic cargo registered an 11.5 percent drop (-7,936 tons).
