Aviation Department - Traffic Statistics

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Notes1: The section entitled Air Transport Association Carriers is included to give a comparison between Port Authority Airport traffic growth and aggregate growth as measured by the majority of the U.S. carrier industry.

Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized."Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

Aviation Department

The region's total passenger traffic achieved a new mark of 11.181 million travelers in the month of September (+482,426 passengers/+4.5 percent). The domestic sector set the pace with a record 6.886 million passengers (+289,013 passengers/+4.4 percent). Carriers grew their domestic seats by 4.1 percent, leading to slightly higher load factors. International passenger activity reached a record 4.295 million passengers (+193,413 travelers/+4.7 percent). International seats grew by 2.5 percent, producing higher load factors. The region's total freight activity inched up 0.8 percent (+1,534 tons). Domestic freight improved by 1.4 percent (+956 tons). International cargo inched up 0.5 percent (+578 tons).
