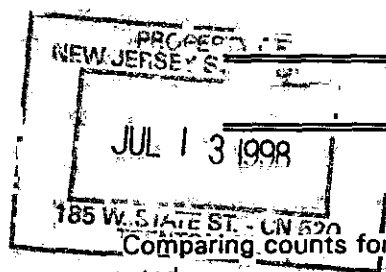

RESIDENTS, ADMISSIONS AND RELEASES
APRIL 1998

Comparing counts for April 30, 1998 with those on April 30, 1997, the following changes are noted:

RESIDENTS

3% increase from 27,585 to 28,354 for the jurisdictional population;
(state inmates in county facilities, prison and youth complexes);
-48% decrease from 5,634 to 2,933 for state inmates in county facilities;
22% increase from 16,921 to 20,618 for the prison complex;
-5% decrease from 5,030 to 4,803 for the youth facilities.

ADMISSIONS

-20% decrease from 1,536 to 1,234 for total admissions.

RELEASES

-18% decrease from 1,443 to 1,180 for total releases;
-28% decrease from 1,028 to 740 for male parole releases;
-26% decrease from 102 to 75 for female parole releases;
-28% decrease from 1,130 to 815 for total parole releases;
17% increase from 313 to 365 for offenders discharged at max.

NOTES: DEFINITIONS OF INMATES INCLUDED IN COUNTS

- a/ RESIDENTS include inmates in the institutions and on furlough on the last day of the reporting period. Past counts for major institutions may include the count for units that are no longer open. Housing security levels are designated as follows: SL I-community, SL II-minimum, SL III-medium, SL IV-maximum and SL V-close.
- b/ ADMISSIONS include commitments, parole returns for technical violation and prison and correctional returns from escape entered into the OBCIS database each month.
- c/ DISCHARGE AT MAX includes adult offenders released upon expiration of maximum sentence. Juvenile offenders are not included in this count.

REPORTING OF JUVENILE RESIDENTS ADMISSIONS AND RELEASES DATA has been discontinued. All juvenile offenders became the responsibility of the Juvenile Justice Commission, Department of Law and Public Safety as of July 1, 1996.

NOTE: Commencing April 1998 County Contract/Assistance and County Waiting figures are merged and reported as State Inmates in County Facilities.
