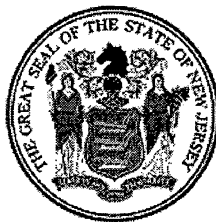

Governor Whitman to Announce \$25,000 Shared Services Grant to Wrightstown, Outline \$1 Billion Property Tax Relief Plan

Gov. Christie Whitman tomorrow will announce that Wrightstown will receive \$25,000 to study the benefits of sharing services with neighbor Plumstead Twp. The Governor will also meet with mayors and legislators from Ocean and Monmouth Counties to discuss her plan to return \$1 billion a year to property taxpayers. The Governor will also tell the mayors that real reform will require the commitment by local officials to shared services and regionalization. The meeting will be held at the Dover Township Municipal Building in Toms River.
