Gov. Christie Whitman today nominated former State Senator Joseph L. Bubba of Wayne to be a member of the State Parole Board. "As a legislator, Joe Bubba spent most of his career as a member of the Senate Law & Public Safety committee, where he was involved with many, if not all, of the major public safety issues facing our state over the past 17 years," said Gov. Whitman. "In his role as a member of the State Parole Board, Joe will continue his efforts to protect the public." Bubba is currently a financial advisor with Prudential Securities. While in the Senate, Bubba served on the Law and Public Safety Committee from 1981-91 and, again, in 1996. He also served on the Criminal Disposition Commission. The State Parole Board is responsible for reviewing and acting on requests for parole. Members serve on the board full-time.
