Aviation Department - Traffic Statistics

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Notes1: The section entitled Air Transport Association Carriers is included to give a comparison between Port Authority Airport traffic growth and aggregate growth as measured by the majority of the U.S. carrier industry.

Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized. "Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ JUNE 2013 TRAFFIC REPORT

The region's passenger traffic grew 1.2% in June, putting overall first half of 2013 growth at 1.8%. This is consistent with our year-end forecast of 1.8% and slightly higher than the nation's 1.4% growth. All the growth emanated from the international sector where YTD passenger traffic jumped 4.3% and seat capacity rose 2.6%. With only 0.5% gain, the domestic sector was tepid as seat capacity shrunk 1.4%. Growth through April had been distorted by weather and Easter, but the May-June average monthly growth of 2% should set the tone for the rest of the year. Cargo continues to remain weak as YTD June level fell 4.2%. Due to the continued weakness, we anticipate that the magnitude of the 2013 cargo decline will probably be larger than the 4% decline predicted for this year.
