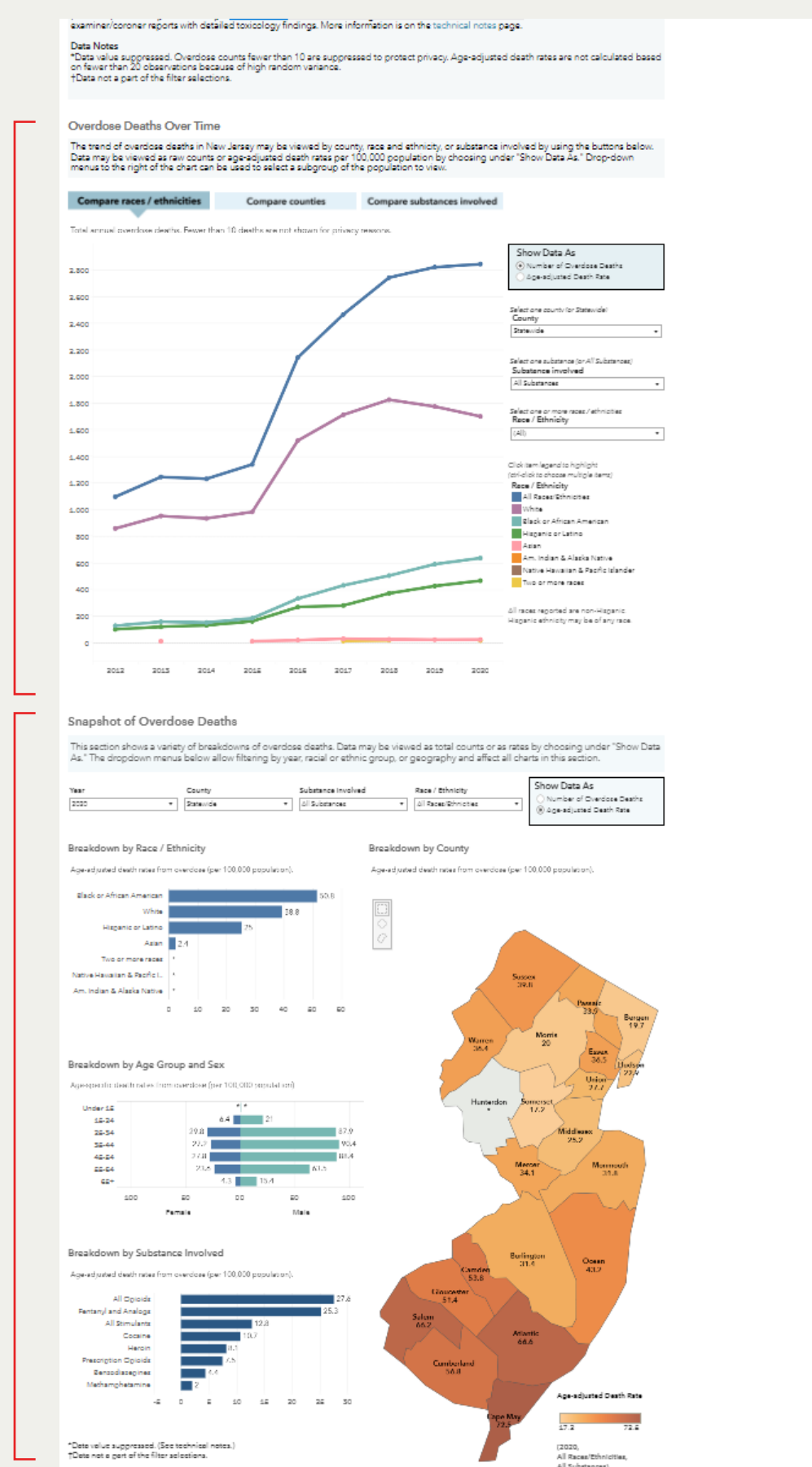


1 The SUDORS data explorer is divided into two portions.

The top section shows a timeline of overdose deaths in New Jersey from 2012 to 2022.

The bottom section shows a "snapshot" for a single year (or all years combined) and breaks down overdose deaths by race/ethnicity, age/sex, substance involved, and county.



2 The timeline shows multiple lines for different races/ethnicities, counties, or substances involved. Choose between these options by clicking on the buttons above the graph.

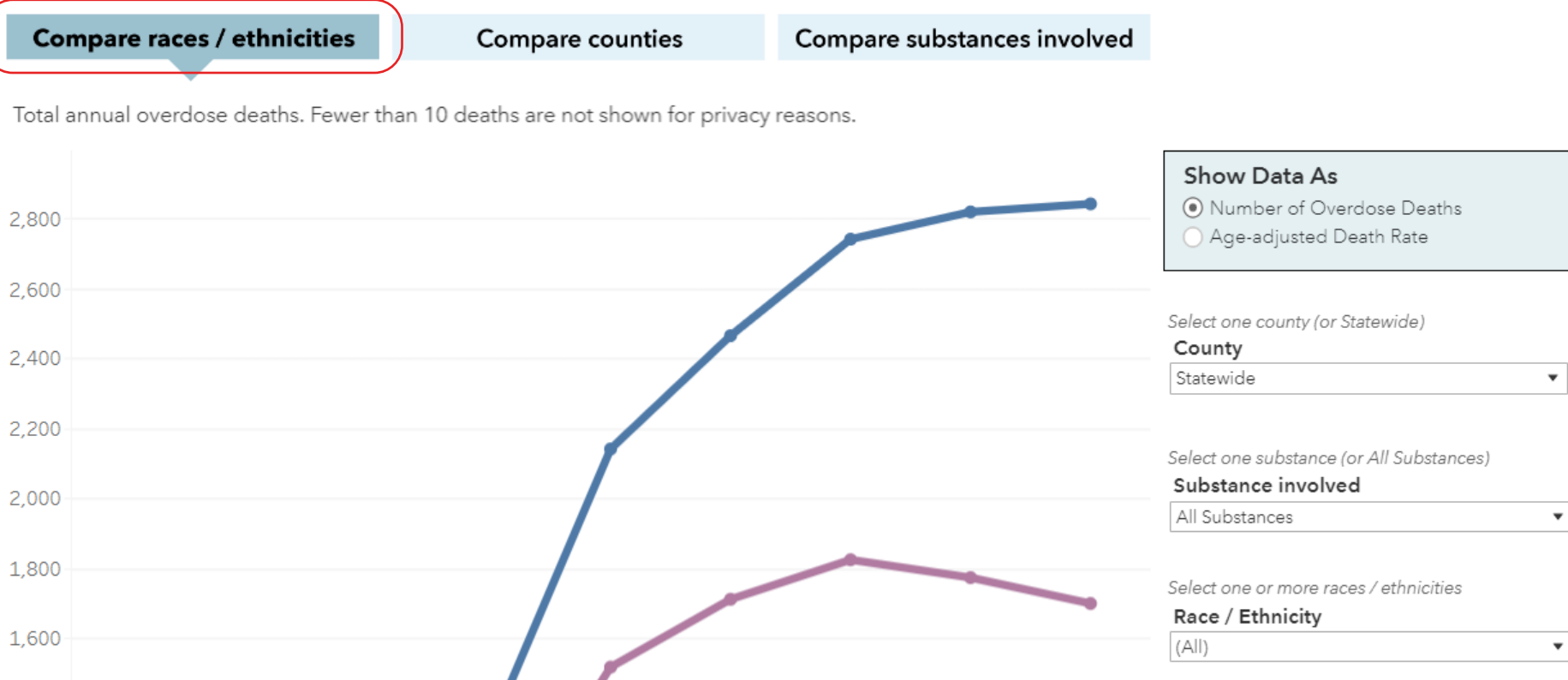
New Jersey SUDORS Overdose Mortality Data Explorer

The drug overdose mortality data presented below comes from New Jersey's State Unintentional Drug Overdose Reporting System (SUDORS). SUDORS provides comprehensive data on unintentional drug overdose deaths collected from death certificates and medical examiner/coroner reports with detailed toxicology findings. 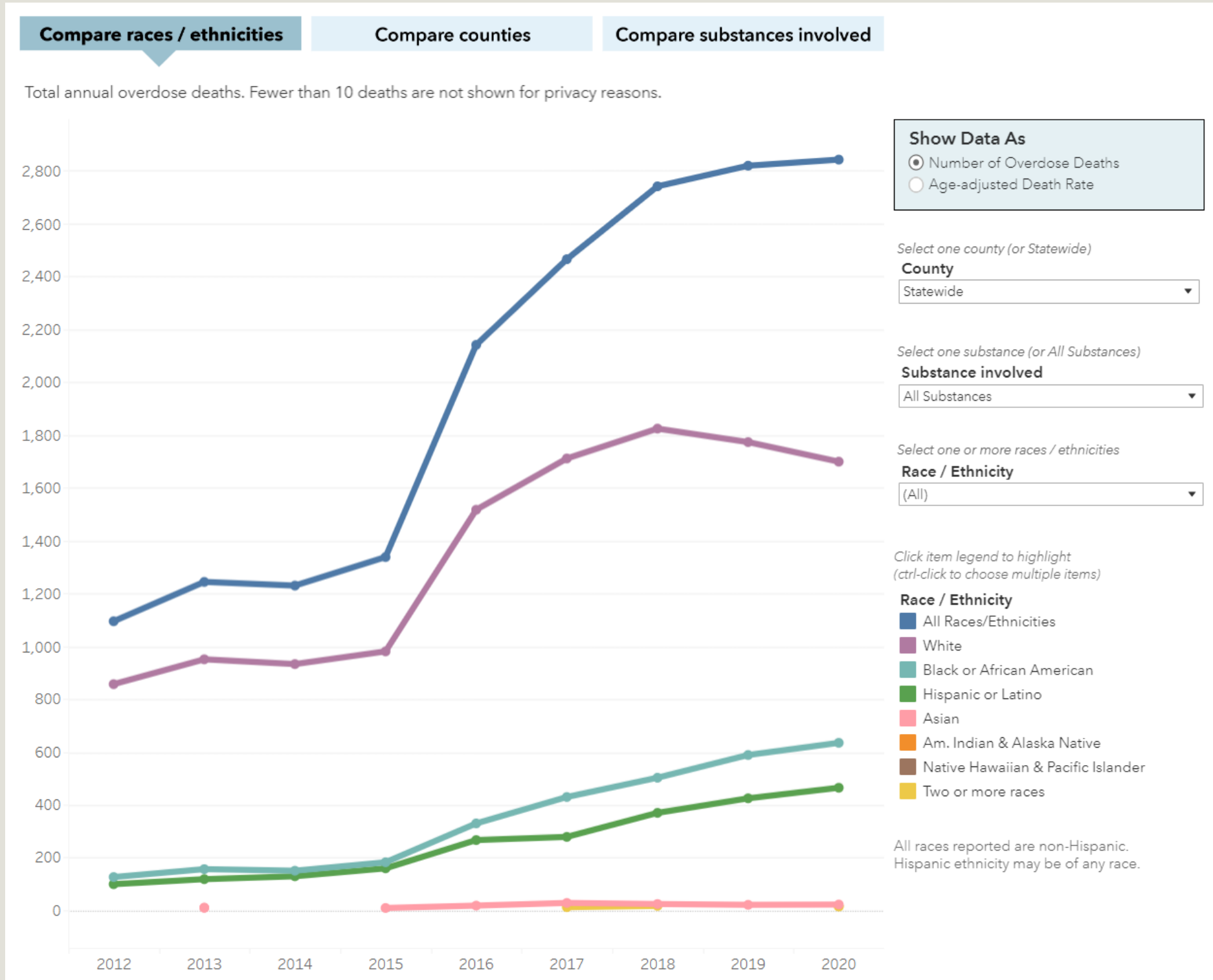

 *Data value suppressed. Overdose counts fewer than 10 are suppressed to protect privacy. Age-adjusted death rates are not calculated based on fewer than 20 observations because of high random variance.

Overdose Deaths Over Time

The trend of overdose deaths in New Jersey may be viewed by county, race and ethnicity, or substance involved by using the buttons below. Data may be viewed as raw counts or age-adjusted death rates per 100,000 population by choosing under "Show Data As." Drop-down menus to the right of the chart can be used to select a subgroup of the population to view.



3 Options for the timeline are on the right-hand side.

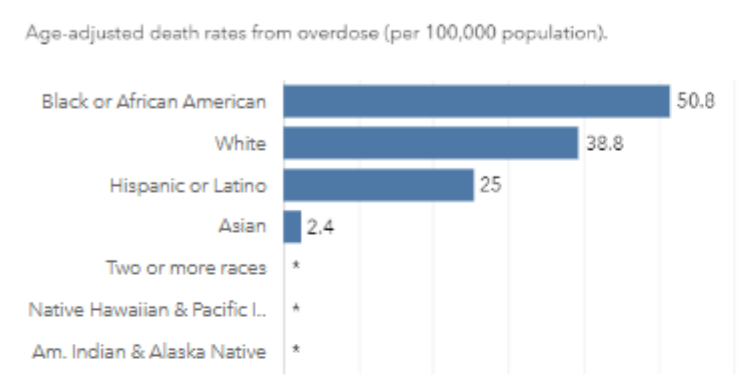
4 Options for the snapshot portion are above the charts and will affect this entire section.

Snapshot of Overdose Deaths

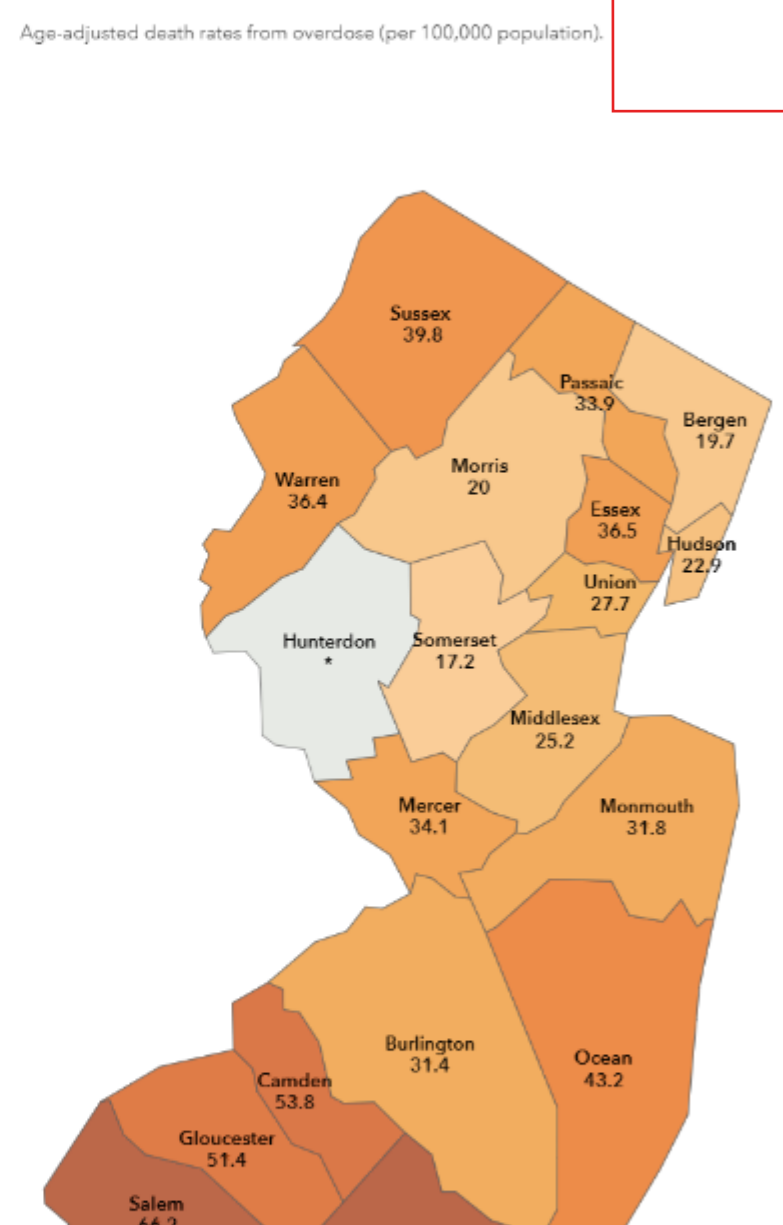

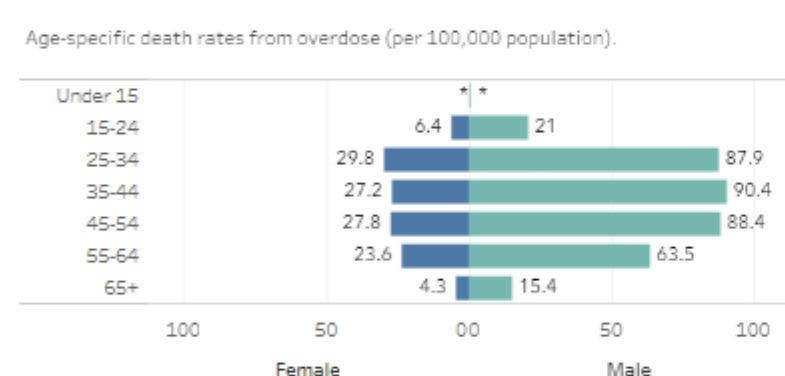
