**Trenton, NJ** – In recognition of Memorial Day, Lt. Governor Kim Guadagno joined the New Jersey Department of Military and Veterans Affairs to honor our fallen soldiers at Brigadier General William C. Doyle Veterans Memorial Cemetery on May 27.

"We're here today to honor and support all those that served and sacrificed, to affirm the respect of a grateful State and Nation, and to feel the depth of sacrifice of generations of brave veterans," said Lt. Governor Guadagno. "And we're here to stand together as one State – and as one people – to appreciate a debt we can never fully repay."

The ceremony included a 21-gun salute and a presentation of memorial wreaths by veteran and service organizations from across New Jersey.

The Brig. Gen. William C. Doyle Veterans Memorial Cemetery is New Jersey's sole state-operated veterans' cemetery. It is the final resting place for nearly 70,000 veterans and family members.
