Aviation Department - Traffic Statistics

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Notes1: The section entitled Air Transport Association Carriers is included to give a comparison between Port Authority Airport traffic growth and aggregate growth as measured by the majority of the U.S. carrier industry.

Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized. "Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

Traffic grew 4.1% in September, the second highest monthly gain this year. The rate put the 1.9% YTD September traffic growth on track to pierce the 2% growth threshold and moved us closer to the year-end traffic forecast of 2.4%. The September growth was remarkable because for the first time this year, the region's domestic traffic growth—a persistent area of weakness—registered its strongest growth, gaining 2.9%. The region's cargo recovery continued from last year's depressive levels as cargo gained 16.7% in September
