E-Adjudication emails from New Jersey’s Division of Unemployment Insurance will always contain your full name and will be sent by **no-reply@dol.nj.gov**.

If you suspect your ID has been stolen, or you believe someone is fraudulently collecting unemployment insurance benefits, let us know right away using either of the methods below.
