The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized."Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

The region's 7.1% passenger growth compares very favorably with the American Transport Association (ATA) U.S. flag carriers November growth rate of negative (5.4%). November marks the first time this year when ATA yields were up in every world region. Regional freight declined (5.8%) compare to (ATA) loss of (4.3%)
