For the seventh straight year, the region's overall air passenger activity achieved an all-time mark as the airports handled 140.5 million travelers, surpassing 2018's total of 138.3 million passengers (+1.6 percent/+2.2 million travelers). The domestic sector (accounting for 64 percent of the region's total passenger volume) led the region's passenger growth with a new mark of 89.5 million passenger (+1.6 percent/+1.4 million passengers). Moreover, our airports served 51 million international travelers (+1.6 percent) and breaking the previous all-time best of 50.2 million passengers reached in 2018. With a dip of 4.7 percent, cargo saw its first decline since 2013's 3.8 percent drop. The international sector (over 60 percent of the region's total freight traffic), led the decline with an 8.3 percent plunge (down 120,672 tons). Conversely, there was good news on the domestic cargo segment, as it registered a 1.4 percent gain – up 12,049 short tons.
