COVID-19 Testing

Middlesex County’s Department of Public Safety & Health and Office of Health Services offer COVID-19 testing for Middlesex County residents. COVID-19 tests performed at the Middlesex County Health Services sites are free for Middlesex County residents, but require an appointment.

Testing days and locations vary on a weekly basis. The table below shows available times and locations:

Those wishing to be tested will be required to make an appointment and meet a set of criteria (listed below). Registration for testing will open 48 hours prior to testing date.

If the resident wishing to be tested does not have access to the internet or has connectivity problems, they are instructed to call 732-745-3100 to make an appointment (open from 8:30 am until 4:15 pm). Appointments will start being made on the day indicated on the table above, and continue until appointment slots fill up, or 48 hours prior to the test date.

CRITERIA FOR TESTING

To receive testing, you must:

- Be a resident, or work or go to school in Middlesex County (proof is required - including, but not limited to: a valid driver’s license; state issued identification; school or employee ID card; or two pieces of mail including utility bills, bank statements, or similar documentation with name and address)
- Make an appointment online or via phone

Middlesex County residents that have symptoms of COVID-19 or believe they have come in contact with someone with COVID-19, should visit middlesexcountynj.gov/COVID19testing to register and receive a time to report to the testing site. Middlesex County also offer testing to asymptomatic (**meaning those not showing symptoms of COVID-19**) individuals. Registrants must bring their appointment confirmation and proof of residency including, but not limited to: a valid driver’s license; state issued identification; or two pieces of mail including utility bills, bank statements, or similar documentation with name and address, to the testing site.

If the person is not a Middlesex County resident or does not have a scheduled appointment, they will not receive testing.
