Veteran-Owned Business Assistance Act Report

REPORT TO THE NEW JERSEY STATE LEGISLATURE AND THE GOVERNOR

Issued pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:32-53

May 14, 2014

Background

P.L. 2011, Chapter 147, the "Veteran-Owned Business Assistance Act," requires Department of the Treasury to create a Veteran-Owned Businesses (VOB) designation with the goal of furthering the State's efforts to encourage these businesses to participate in State procurements. The Act charges Treasury, in consultation with the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs (DMAVA) and the New Jersey Economic Development Authority (NJEDA), with identifying strategies to ensure that VOBs are aware of State procurement opportunities.

The "Veteran-Owned Business Assistance Act" requires each State contracting agency to submit an annual report to Treasury detailing the total dollar value and number of contracts awarded to VOBs in the preceding fiscal year, the types and sizes of businesses receiving contract awards, and the nature of the purchases and contracts; however, technological and logistical challenges hampered Treasury's Division of Purchase and Property's (DPP) efforts to obtain data from other contracting agencies prior to the publication of this report. Nonetheless, the Division, which handles State procurements for most State departments and agencies, has access within its databases to the Fiscal Year 2013 data it is required to produce under P.L 2011, Chapter 147, which it used to produce this report. Moving forward, Treasury will ensure that all contracting agencies submit their Fiscal Year 2014 reports to Treasury no later than November 1, 2014 and will continue this process in the coming years.

As mentioned in the previous paragraph, until recently, Treasury experienced technical difficulties when it attempted to add the VOB designation in the State's Selective Assistance Vendor Information (SAVI) portal. However, we are pleased to report that VOB registrants can now be sourced in the SAVI system, which will also enhance visibility for vendors seeking subcontractors. Vendors interested in obtaining designation as a VOB may find more information at the State's Business Portal.

We are also pleased to report that DPP's newly formed Vendor Outreach Team is currently working with leaders in the veteran community and the State's Small Business Development Center to locate VOBs interested in participating in State procurement opportunities, in addition to providing these veteran business owners with guidance. The Department looks forward to reporting an increase in VOB registrants and contract spend as a result of those efforts both in the Fiscal Year 2014 report and in future reports.

Fiscal Year 2013 Results

In total, 49 entities registered as VOBs (see Appendix A) and eight were active State vendors in Fiscal Year 2013. The total spend with these eight VOBs was \$5,807,304 (see Appendix B), as they provided the State with a variety of goods and services, from vehicle parts to engineering, pest control and property management services.

As you will see in Appendix A, the spreadsheet includes the name of every VOB registered with the State, the business's principal location, and information on the size of each VOB based on the amount of revenue it generates annually (below is a breakdown on the size of each business). The revenue column denotes whether the VOB is engaged in Construction (nine companies), Goods & Services (20 companies), or both Construction and Goods & Services (19 companies).

Goods & Services (20 companies)

- 15 companies with sales under \$500,000 annually
- three companies with annual sales between \$500,000 and \$5 million annually
- two companies with annual sales over \$5 million but under \$12 million or the Federal Standard

Construction (ten companies)

- nine companies with sales under \$3 million annually
- zero companies with annual sales under 50% of Annual Federal Standard
- one company with annual sales under the Annual Federal Standard

Construction and Goods & Services (19 companies)

- seven companies with annual Goods and Services sales under \$500,000 and Construction sales under \$3 million
- six companies with annual Goods and Services sales between \$500,000 and \$5 million & Construction sales under \$3 million
- three companies with annual Goods and Services sales between \$500,000 and \$5 million & Construction sales under 50% of Annual Federal Standard
- one company with annual Goods and Services sales over \$5 million & Construction sales under 50% of Annual Federal Standard
- two companies with Goods and Services sales over \$5 million annually & Construction sales under the Annual Federal Standard

In terms of the eight VOBs that were State vendors in Fiscal Year 2013, listed below is information that provides a breakdown of the different types of companies based on the business they're engaged in and their revenues:

Goods & Services (four companies)

- two companies with sales under \$500,000 annually
- one company with annual sales between \$500,000 and \$5 million
- one company with annual sales over \$5 million but under \$12 million or the Federal Standard

Construction (one company)

• one company with sales under \$3 million annually

Construction and Goods & Services (three companies)

- one company with annual Goods and Services sales between \$500,000 and \$5 million &
 Construction sales under \$3 million
- one company with annual Goods and Services sales over \$5 million but under \$12 million or the Federal Standard & Construction sales under 50% of Annual Federal Standard
- one company with Goods and Services sales over \$5 million annually but under \$12 million or the Federal Standard & Construction sales under the Annual Federal Standard
