SUBJECT: Termination of the Health Access New Jersey Program

The purpose of this Communication is to advise that funding for the Health Access New Jersey Program (HANJP) ceased as of November 1, 2001. Current HANJP enrollees have been transferred to the NJ FamilyCare program, effective November 1, 2001 and are eligible to receive Plan D services. These enrollees have been noticed and advised of their responsibilities to enroll in NJ FamilyCare.

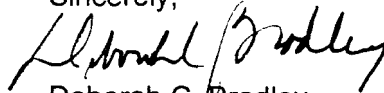
The following new program status codes have been added to identify these individuals:

Program Status Code 300	Income between	0-150% FPL
Program Status Code 301	Income between	151-250% FPL (premium required)
Program Status Code 700	Income between	0-150% FPL
Program Status Code 701	Income between	151-250% FPL (premium required)

Individuals identified by Program Status Codes 300 and 301 are parents and Program Status Codes 700 and 701 identify single adults and childless couples. Maximus will be responsible for determining the ongoing eligibility for these individuals.
