Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized. "Flights (daily)" refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

A snowstorm in late January severely affecting traffic together with the Y2K resulted in disappointing traffic results.
