



the cut-off score will be funded according to priority, in rank order to the extent of available funds. Priority 1 projects will be funded first by rank, highest to lowest; when priority 1 projects have all been funded, priority 2 projects will be funded according to rank. In the event of tied scores, each applicant will be fully funded pending availability of funds.

If funds cannot fully fund each project, the funds will be divided among the tied projects using a formula based on the ratio of funds requested to funds available.
