## P R E F A C E .

The year 1804 marked the beginning of the history of Banking in the State of New Jersey.

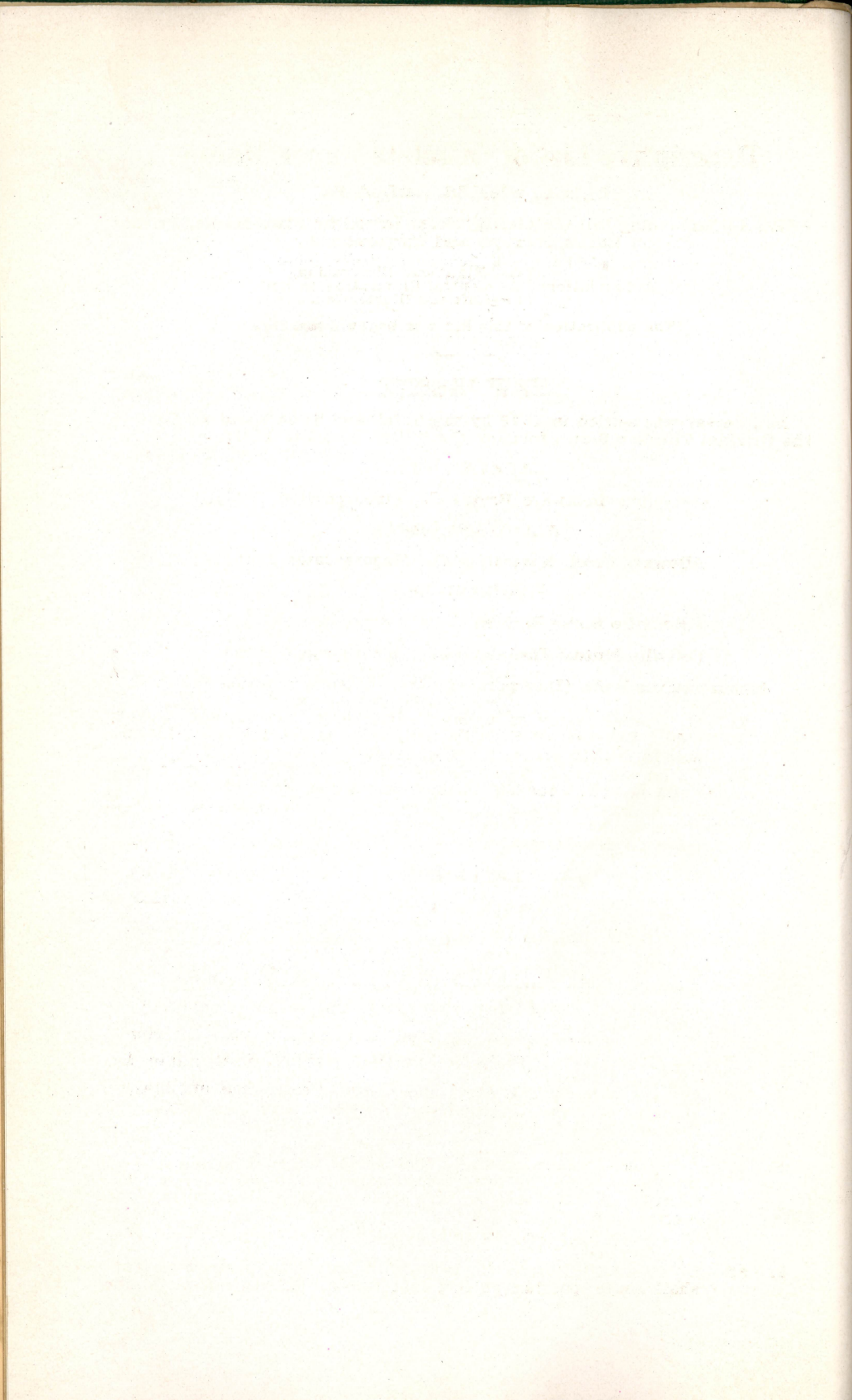
The Newark Banking and Insurance Company, of Newark, was chartered by the Legislature, February 18, 1804. The title was changed to The Newark Banking Company, March 31, 1855, and then to The National Newark Banking Company, June 24, 1865. The first President was Elisha Boudinot, a prominent citizen of the State at that time. The first day's deposits were \$4,000.00.

The Trenton Banking Company was chartered by the Legislature, December 3, 1804, and has had a very interesting and important career. The first President was Isaac Smith. He was a Supreme Court Justice for eighteen years; also a member of the Continental Congress, and a Colonel in the Continental Army. This Bank has continued to do business under its State Charter to the present time; it is unique in this respect.

A long period of time has elapsed since the Paper Money described in the accompanying List was issued and circulated as money "good as gold"; so that the List is not complete inasmuch as many of the notes were not preserved, other notes turn up from time to time, and so on. However, it is remarkable that it is possible to record nine hundred and forty six notes.

In conclusion, a word of appreciation to H. E. Deats, Esq., Flemington, New Jersey, who aided in compiling this List by kindly forwarding his Collection of Paper Money for examination, and for obtaining descriptions of notes which had not been recorded.
