Notes1: The section entitled Air Transport Association Carriers is included to give a comparison between Port Authority Airport traffic growth and aggregate growth as measured by the majority of the U.S. carrier industry.

Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline ADI summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized. "Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

Aviation Department

The COVID-19 crisis continues to affect our region's domestic and international air passenger traffic. Total passenger volume sank by 83.9 percent year-over-year in the month of August – down 11.13 million travelers. Accounting for over 70 percent of the region's total air traveler volume, the domestic sector recorded an 80.3 percent plunge – down 6.482 million passengers. International passenger activity fell by 89.4 percent – down 4.643 million travelers. Driven by the international sector's sixth straight monthly double-digit decline (-30,293 short tons / 28.2 percent), the region's total air freight volume fell 14.9 percent (-26,454 short tons). Domestic cargo was more resilient, recording growth of 3,839 short tons (+5.5 percent), as JFK, LGA, and SWF grew their domestic cargo traffic by jointly handling 8,603 additional short tons compared to August 2019.
