The region's passenger traffic grew 3.1% in the first quarter of 2013, on track with the forecast and faster than the nation's 1.3% growth. 1st quarter growth benefited significantly from three factors: A milder January compared to last year's; the occurrence of 2013's Easter in March versus April 2012; and a strong underlying demand. Cargo continued to be weak. It declined 4% and the year end cargo has been revised downward to -3.8%.
