

CHAPTER 53
PURCHASE OF SURPLUS MILITARY
WEAPONS AND EQUIPMENT

Authority

Unless otherwise expressly noted, all provisions of this Chapter 53 were adopted by the Division of State Police pursuant to authority of Executive Order No. 14, and were filed and became effective June 4, 1971, as R.1971 d.87. See: 3 N.J.R. 87(b), 3 N.J.R. 136(e).

Chapter Expiration Date

Chapter 53. Purchase of Surplus Military Weapons and Equipment, expires on July 1, 2006.

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SUBCHAPTER 1. RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES

13:53-1.1 Lists

Listed as Appendices A through D of this Chapter are the surplus weapons, ammunition and equipment to be sold, at fair market value, when available, by the United States Secretary of Defense.

13:53-1.2 Certification

(a) When ordering equipment, certification of the requisition must be completed by one of the following:

1. Director of Public Safety;
2. Chief of police;
3. Chief of the fire department.

(b) Purchase requests must be in the format prescribed in Appendix E of this Chapter, to the Superintendent of the New Jersey State Police.

13:53-1.3 Limitation

(a) Only one line item per request will be accepted. (Example: If the requesting agency is ordering 100 gas masks with a stock number 4240-880-0009, and 100 gas masks with a stock number of 4240-880-0010, it would be necessary to complete and submit two requisitions.

(b) It is essential that all information required be provided; if omitted, the application will be rejected and returned.

13:53-1.4 Copies of requisition

(a) Three copies of each requisition must be received by the Superintendent of State Police with the following disposition:

1. One copy to be retained at State Police Headquarters;
2. Two copies to be forwarded to the Defense Logistics Service Center; (DLSC) Federal Center; Battle Creek, Michigan 49016.

13:53-1.5 Procedures

(a) All applications must be forwarded to, and certified by the Superintendent of the New Jersey State Police.

(b) Requests sent directly to the DLSC, without the signature of the Superintendent, and the official seal of the New Jersey State Police will be returned, unprocessed, for the necessary corrective action.

(c) All applications received at Defense Logistics Services Center (DLSC), will be forwarded to the Department of Justice, Law Enforcement Assistance Administration, Washington, D.C. for suitability and priority clearance and consummation of the sale with the requested agency at the sale price shown in the appropriate Appendix of this Chapter.

(d) Requests received by DLSC are separated by Federal stock number and placed on file pending receipt of asset reports from the Property Disposal Officer, Weapons Command and Army Procurement Supply Agency. Asset reports are scheduled to reach DLSC on January 10, April 10, July 10 and October 10, of each year. These asset reports are matched with requisition reports on file. Matched reports, assets and requisition, are forwarded to LEAA for approval and assignment of priority. LEAA is the final authority for deciding the issuance of the quantity of what equipment is available.

(e) The requisitioning agency will be notified of the unavailability of the requested equipment and the application will be retained by DLSC for a period of 90 days. If

the requested item does not become available within this period of time, the application will be returned to the agency and no further action will be taken on the request.

(f) Expenses of packing, handling, crating and transportation will be borne by the purchasing agency, and will be included in the billing document. Payment will be made in accordance with instructions from DLSC.

(g) The requesting agency will be notified of approved requisitions via mail from the DLSC. Together with this letter will be a DD Form 1427, titled, "Notice of Award, Statement and Release Document". Instructions as to payment are also contained in this letter. Property may be obtained by the requisitioner with payment being made subsequently.

(h) Only under "absolute necessity" circumstances will the Government pack and ship the property to the requesting agency. If this is the case, an additional charge will be made which is based upon the total contract price. This is approximately three per cent for packing and three per cent for transportation. The cover letter would indicate the specific costs.

(i) If possible, it is desirable to have the requisitioning agency make all arrangements for packing, pickup and transportation. As suggested by the DLSC, this can usually be done through a commercial trucking agency situated in the area or city where the property is physically located. The DD Form No. 1427 will require removal of the property within a 45-day period from the date of the award cover letter.

(j) Requisitions which are not filled within the 90-day cycle will be returned to the requesting agency. Applications can be resubmitted sometime prior to the next cycle. (January-April-July-October).

(k) Upon the receipt of firearms, an authenticated inventory, listing make, type and serial number will be forwarded to the Superintendent of State Police. The weapons will be registered with the Firearms Investigation Unit, Records and Identification Section, West Trenton, New Jersey.

(l) Items which are no longer serviceable or operable will be destroyed in such a manner as to preclude reconstruction. Serial numbers of destroyed firearms will be recorded on the back of DD Form 1427, and the certificate thereon will be executed and forwarded:

(m) All reasonable requisitions, compatible with the size of the department/agency, will be forwarded to DLSC.

(n) Questionable requisitions will be cause for an investigation which could either reject or result in the re-evaluation of the submitted requests. Example: The request by a firefighting agency, for weapons and/or ammunition.

(o) All applications will be checked to insure accuracy, correct stock numbers, prices and adherence to these rules, regulations and procedures.

(p) Rejected State level requisitions will be returned to the appropriate agency, with a cover letter, indicating cause for rejection or return. (See Appendix G). Questionable applications will be retained by the Superintendent of State Police pending the investigation as indicated in subsection (n) of this Section, and will be forwarded or returned with a full explanation.

(q) Rejected Federal level requisitions will be reviewed by the Superintendent, if correctable at the State level, will be corrected and returned to the rejecting Federal agency. Uncorrectable items, at the State level, will be returned to the requesting agency, and after alteration, may be resubmitted.

(r) The head of the agency requesting any type weapons will be required to provide written certification to the Superintendent of the New Jersey State Police, attesting to the training and qualifications of their personnel with the surplus military weapons, within 90 days after their receipt.

(s) The Superintendent of the New Jersey State Police from time to time may promulgate additional rules and regulations governing these requests/requisitions for surplus military weapons, ammunition and equipment.

(t) A sample application is attached, hypothetically completed, for use as a guide by all agencies concerned. (See Appendix H.)

APPENDIX F

§ 2576. Surplus military equipment; sale to State and local law enforcement and firefighting agencies

(a) The Secretary of Defense, under regulations prescribed by him, may sell to State and local law enforcement and firefighting agencies, at fair market value, pistols, revolvers, shotguns, rifles of a caliber not exceeding .30, ammunition for such firearms, gas masks, and protective body armor which (1) are suitable for use by such agencies in carrying out law enforcement and firefighting activities, and (2) have been determined to be surplus property pursuant to the Federal Property and Administrative Services Act of 1949 (63 Stat. 377), as amended.

(b) Such surplus military equipment shall not be sold under the provisions of this section to a State or local law enforcement or firefighting agency unless request therefor is made by such agency, in such form and manner as the Secretary of Defense shall prescribe, and such request, with respect to the type and amount of equipment so requested, is certified as being necessary and suitable for the operation of such agency by the Governor (or such State official as he may designate) of the State in which such agency is located. Equipment sold to a State or local law enforcement or firefighting agency under this section shall not exceed, to qualify, the amount requested and certified for such agency and shall be for the exclusive use of such agency. Such equipment may not be sold, or otherwise transferred, by such agency to any individual or public or private organization or agency.
