The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized."Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

The 6.5% growth in traffic this month delivered the best April in our history, a pleasant surprise that testified to the resiliency of our region. With 9.9 million passengers using our facilities, we were able to shrug off the weather blues from the first quarter. While domestic passenger traffic increased 3.3%, international travel was the main driver of growth with a strong 12.8% increase that pushed YTD up to 1.4%. Pent-up demand was unleashed, driven by great weather, a solid Easter travel period, a 3.1% seat capacity increase and relatively high load factors. Region's cargo posted a 2.7% increase. Even though our domestic cargo decreased 1.6%, it was still good news, as the decrease was one of the smallest we have seen since January 2013. International cargo posted a strong 5% increase and pushed monthly tonnage into positive territory for the month.
