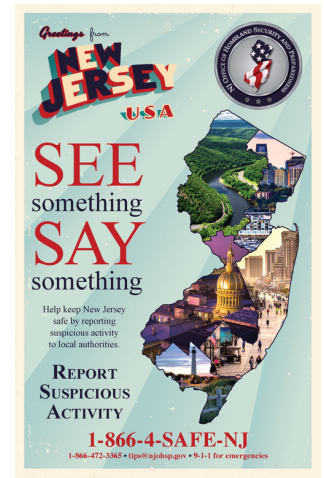

Surveillance

Acquiring Expertise

Gaining skills or knowledge on a specific topic, such as facility security, military



Eliciting Information

Questioning personnel beyond mere curiosity about an event, facility, or



Misrepresentation

Presenting false information or misusing documents to conceal possible illegal



Testing Security

Probing or testing a facility's security or IT systems to assess the strength or



Theft/Loss/Diversion

Stealing or diverting items—such as equipment, uniforms, or badges—that



Recruiting

Attempting to recruit or radicalize others by providing tradecraft advice



Financing

Providing direct financial support to operations teams and contacts, often through

Disrupting or compromising an organization's information technology
