Aviation Department - Traffic Statistics

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Notes1: The section entitled Air Transport Association Carriers is included to give a comparison between Port Authority Airport traffic growth and aggregate growth as measured by the majority of the U.S. carrier industry.

Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline ADI summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized."Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

**Aviation Department**  
 Calendar year 2020—a year of unparalleled challenges in the history of commercial aviation due to the impact of COVID-19—closed with total passenger traffic across all Port Authority airports at just one-third of 2019 traffic. Total passenger volume sank by 70.9 percent for the year (-99.632 million) and 75.3 percent for December 2020 versus December 2019 (-8.929 million). Accounting for over 71 percent of the region's total air traveler volume in December 2020, the domestic sector recorded a 73.1 percent plunge – down 5.685 million passengers. International passenger activity fell by 79.5 percent – down 3.243 million travelers. Overall, total regional air cargo volume in 2020 was more resilient than passenger traffic volume, but still ended the year down over 14 percent relative to 2019 volume. After recording 11 straight months of declines, primarily due to double-digit declines in international cargo, total air cargo rose 2.7 percent in December, powered by 29.8 percent growth in domestic cargo (104,543 short tons) compared to December 2019. International cargo volume somewhat offset these gains, recording a 16.4 percent decline (-18,658 short tons).
