

2. *And be it enacted*, That the sum of ten thousand dollars is hereby appropriated for the erection and furnishing of a new family house, and for grading and planting the grounds. Appropriation for family house.

3. *And be it enacted*, That the treasurer of the state is hereby directed to pay to the trustees of the school the aforesaid sums on the warrant of the comptroller. To be paid on warrant of the comptroller.

CHAPTER CCCXXXVI.

A Supplement to an act entitled "An Act to establish a System of Public Instruction," approved March twenty-first, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-seven.

1. BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey*, That hereafter no person shall be eligible to the office of school trustee unless he or she can read or write; and women who are residents in the district and over the age of twenty-one years shall also be eligible to the office of school trustee, and may hold such office and perform the duties of the same when duly elected by the legal voters of the district. Women shall be eligible to the office of school trustee.

2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect immediately.

CHAPTER CCCLIX.

A Further Supplement to the Act Respecting Conveyances, approved April fifteenth, one thousand eight hundred and forty-six.

WHEREAS, before the act setting off the county of Hudson from the county of Bergen took effect, certain conveyances of lands lying in that part of Bergen afterwards Preamble.
