2. And be it enacted, That the sum of ten thousand dollars Appropriation for family hor family house, and for grading and planting the grounds.

3. And be it enacted, That the treasurer of the state is To be paid on warrant hereby directed to pay to the trustees of the school the of the compaforesaid sums on the warrant of the comptroller.

CHAPTER CCCXXXVI.

- A Supplement to an act entitled "An Act to establish a System of Public Instruction," approved March twentyfirst, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-seven.
- 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and General Assembly of women shall be eligible to the office of school trustee unless he or she can read or write; and women who are residents in the district and over the age of twenty-one years shall also be eligible to the office of school trustee, and may hold such office and perform the duties of the same when duly elected by the legal voters of the district.

2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect imme-

diately.
