MASS TORTS – APPLICATION TO DESIGNATE LITIGATION INVOLVING THE GADOLINIUM-BASED DIAGNOSTIC CONTRAST AGENT OMNISCANTM AS A MASS TORT

Pursuant to Rule 4:38A and the Mass Tort Guidelines and Criteria for Designation (Directive #10-07), an application has been made to the Supreme Court, through the Administrative Director of the Courts, to designate all New Jersey state-court litigation involving the gadolinium-based diagnostic contrast agent Omniscantm, as a mass tort for centralized management and for assignment of that mass tort to the Middlesex Vicinage and Judge Jamie D.
