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
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## 2013 HIGHLIGHTS


- Over \$13 billion was authorized by building permits in 2013. This was nearly \$2.1 billion more than last year, an increase of 19.2 percent. The last time there was more activity was 2008.
- The dollar amount of construction for new houses was \$3.28 billion. This was 36.4 percent more than in 2012. New Jersey building departments issued permits for 18,795 new dwellings in 2013. This was 3,525 more than last year, for an increase of 23.1 percent. The last time there was more new housing was 2007.
- Home repairs accounted for \$3.618 billion in 2013. This was 22.9 percent more than last year. All told, new home construction and residential additions and alterations totaled \$6.9 billion, or 52.9 percent of all authorized activity.
- Not all areas of the industry did well. Office development declined by 21.2 percent compared to last year. Retail construction is up slightly, but still well below levels in previous years.
- Office, retail, and other nonresidential work accounted for \$6.1 billion of in 2013. New buildings totaled \$1.895 billion. Nonresidential renovations, which include tenant fit outs, totaled \$4.245 billion.

- As a region, North Jersey had the most work and new houses. The estimated cost of construction was \$5.8 billion. This was 44.8 percent of the entire State.
- North Jersey had 8,424 authorized housing units in 2013; this was 44.8 percent of the State total.



- Central Jersey had \$4.837 billion of work (37.1 percent) and 39.8 percent of all authorized housing (nearly 7,500 new dwellings).
- South Jersey had \$1.9 billion of construction in 2013; this was 14.8 percent of all authorized work in the State.
- State Buildings accounted for \$451.8 million in 2013; this was 3.5 percent of all authorized activity in New Jersey. This category of building permits includes projects by New Jersey State government agencies and their instrumentalities, like New Jersey Transit. The projects are located throughout the state. Some of the bigger developments in 2013 were for work at public colleges and universities, including Montclair State University, Ramapo College, Rutgers University, and William Paterson University. Other big developments were a new race track and entertainment and retail complex in the Meadowlands.

### **Top Municipalities**

- For more than ten years, no other municipality has more construction and new housing than Jersey City. This trend continued in 2013. Jersey City led all municipalities with \$689.8 million of construction. The City also was tops with 1,705 authorized dwellings. New houses and home repairs accounted for 63.6 percent of all activity in Jersey City. Three other Hudson County communities also were among the top twelve with the most new housing. The Hudson River waterfront is still golden.
- Newark in Essex County had \$525.9 million of construction and 309 new dwellings, 7<sup>th</sup> among municipalities. No other locality issued building permits in 2013 for more new office space, 778,000 square feet. This accounted for 13.3 percent of all the new office spaced in the State. Most of this was for the new corporate headquarters for Prudential Insurance and Panasonic Electronics.
- Newly consolidated Princeton (Mercer County) had \$225.1 million of construction and 518 new dwellings. Only Jersey City and Weehawken, both in Hudson County, had more new housing.
- Another Mercer County community, Robbinsville, had \$173.1 million of construction in 2013. Work began on a 1.961 million square foot distribution center for internet retailer Amazon.com. This accounted for 61.3 percent of activity in Robbinsville and more than 20 percent of all the new warehouse space authorized in New Jersey in 2013.



- Paramus in Bergen County had \$165.8 million of work. Two of the bigger projects were renovations of the Garden State Plaza shopping mall and parking deck.
- Woodbridge (Middlesex County) had \$164.1 million of construction. A new large distribution center is under construction for Federal Express. Several other larger warehouses were started in 2013. Woodbridge's building department issued permits for about 1.3 million square feet of new warehouse and storage space in 2013.
- Over three-quarters of the construction in Toms River were for new houses or home repair. The Ocean County community had 429 authorized dwellings in 2013. Only five other municipalities had more.

### **Super Storm Sandy**

- Hurricane Sandy's effect on construction in New Jersey was measurable and mixed.
- Early impacts were disruptive. Some of the biggest declines in activity in recent years were in November 2012, the first month after the storm.
- Home repairs increased significantly in 2013. The federal government designated nine New Jersey counties eligible for disaster relief: Atlantic; Bergen; Cape May; Essex; Hudson; Middlesex; Monmouth; Ocean; and Union.
- The dollar amount of home renovations in these counties totaled \$2.48 billion in 2013. This was 28.3 percent more than last year.

- In the other 12 counties, the dollar amount of work authorized for residential additions and alterations also increased, but at a more modest rate (11.1 percent).



- House demolitions increased significantly after the storm. In 2013, New Jersey building departments issued permits to remove 7,295 dwellings. This was more than double the number last year.
- Toms River in Ocean County led all municipalities with 1,108 housing demolitions. The top three municipalities and nine of the top 20 were in Ocean County.



### **New Houses**

- New home construction has changed significantly in recent years. Housing has become more complex. More new dwellings are in multifamily and mixed-use buildings.
- In 1996, most of the new housing authorized by building permits was single-family, detached units. Just over 15 percent were in multifamily or mixed-use buildings.
- In 2013, 48.6 percent of all authorized dwellings were in multifamily or mixed-used buildings.

- Another significant trend is the amount of residential development in New Jersey’s two largest cities, Newark and Jersey City. Since 2001, both cities have remained among the top municipalities with the most new housing.
- Jersey City has ranked either first or second in 12 of the past 13 years.

### New Home Prices

- A total of 7,861 new houses were built and began enrollment in a new home warranty program in 2013. Half of these houses cost more than \$399,000. This \$900 less than the median sale prices last year.
- The most expensive new houses are in Bergen, Somerset, Essex, and Hudson Counties.
- Not every house gets a new home warranty. Rental units are excluded, as are new houses built by homeowners who acted as their own general contractors.

**T**HE NEW JERSEY CONSTRUCTION REPORTER contains statistics on construction activity in New Jersey. Information in the report comes from construction officials who administer the State Uniform Construction Code (UCC) (N.J.A.C. 5:23-1 et seq.) in New Jersey's 566 municipalities.

Each month, construction officials send to the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs (DCA) reports on the permits and certificates they issue. Permits authorize the start of construction and cover four types of activity: (1) New construction permits authorize the start of a new structure. (2) Permits for additions refer to work that will add space (volume and square feet) to an existing building. (3) Alterations also involve existing structures, but the work authorized will not add space. Typically, construction officials issue permits for alterations when the work is subject to one or more of the UCC's major subcodes (building, electrical, plumbing, fire protection). (4) Demolition permits authorize the removal of a building or some other structure. The *CONSTRUCTION REPORTER* identifies only those demolitions that will result in the loss of housing.

In addition to permits, the *CONSTRUCTION REPORTER* has information on the certificates issued by construction officials. While permits authorize the start of construction, certificates are issued for work completed and ready for occupancy. Each month, the *CONSTRUCTION REPORTER* will report on the number of housing units and the amount of office and retail space authorized for construction, along with the number of housing units and the amount of office and retail space completed.

### **Data Comparability**

The *CONSTRUCTION REPORTER* contains information on authorized housing units that is tabulated two different ways. The DCA tabulates Tables 1 through 3 and Tables 8 through 13 based on the use of buildings, defined in "groups" by New Jersey's UCC. Exhibit B on page 3 summarizes these groups.

Tables 4, 5, and 6 show authorized housing units as defined and tabulated by the United States Census Bureau. The New Jersey Department of Labor and Workforce Development prepares these tables for publication in the *CONSTRUCTION REPORTER*. Exhibit C on page 4 describes the housing definitions used by the Census Bureau.

The DCA series and the Census Bureau series on authorized housing units differ two important ways. First, the DCA series includes housing units created as a result of permits issued to alter or make additions to existing structures. The Census Bureau counts only those housing units authorized from permits issued for new construction.

Second, the Census Bureau imputes data for localities that fail to submit monthly reports on time. An asterisk in the Census column of data appearing in the Municipal Summary Data table at the back of the *CONSTRUCTION REPORTER* indicates those towns with imputed data. The Census Bureau bases these imputations on historic trends. The DCA series shows information for only those towns that submitted monthly reports. If a municipality failed to submit a monthly report on time, "No report" appears in the appropriate columns in the Municipal Summary Data table.

### **Additional Terms**

A number of other terms appear in the tables throughout the *CONSTRUCTION REPORTER*. Exhibit A on page 2 defines additional construction permit and certificate terms.

## Exhibit A

Summary of Building Permit and Certificate Terms	
<b>Addition</b>	Permit type issued for construction work that adds space (volume and square feet) to an existing structure.
<b>Alteration</b>	Permit type involving one or more subcodes (building, electrical, fire protection, and plumbing). The work is authorized for an existing structure and does not add new space.
<b>Certificate</b>	A document issued by a construction official indicating completion of work for which a permit was issued.
<b>Dollar Amount of Construction</b>	Estimated cost of work, as reported by the permit applicant to the construction official.
<b>Demolition</b>	Permit type authorizing the demolition of an existing structure.
<b>Housing Units Certified</b>	A rental or for-sale unit completed and certified by the construction official for conforming to the standards in the New Jersey UCC.
<b>Housing Units Authorized by Building Permits</b>	A rental or for-sale dwelling unit authorized by a construction permit. See Exhibits B and C for explanations of the different definitions of housing structures. The Table 1 series and Tables 2 and 3 show housing units as classified by the residential use groups defined in Exhibit B. Tables 4, 5, and 6 identify authorized housing as defined by the U.S. Census Bureau. (See Exhibit C.)
<b>Housing Unit Demolitions</b>	Rental or for-sale housing to be demolished, as reported to the construction official by permit applicants.
<b>New Construction</b>	Permit type authorizing the start of a new structure.
<b>Permit</b>	A document issued by construction officials that authorizes the construction of a new structure or an addition, alteration, or demolition of an existing structure.
<b>Square Feet</b>	Estimated building area, as reported on permits for new construction and additions.
<b>State Buildings</b>	Buildings or structures constructed or owned by the State or any of its instrumentalities. Construction activity reported in this category includes State offices, colleges, hospitals, prisons, facilities operated by New Jersey Transit and the New Jersey Sports and Exposition Authority, and other State authorities.

**Exhibit B**

<b>Building Groups</b>	
<b>Residential</b>	Buildings where members of households live. Examples of residential groups include: one- and two-family houses (R-3 and R-5); apartments, dormitories, other multifamily houses (R-2); and mixed-use housing, where the house is a relatively smaller part of a building that has another use (e.g., an apartment over a store). Therapeutic residences (R-4) for 6 to 16 occupants are also included in this category. The Table 1 series and Tables 2 and 3 show authorized housing units by group definition.
----- <b>The following groups refer to industrial, commercial, and other nonresidential structures.</b> -----	
<b>Assembly</b>	Structures where people gather for civic, social, or religious purposes. Examples include: theaters and concert halls (group A-1); night clubs, dance halls, casino gaming areas, restaurants, taverns, and bars (A-2); churches, libraries, amusement arcades, community halls, gymnasiums, indoor swimming pools, art galleries, and museums (A-3); arenas, skating rinks, swimming pools, tennis courts (A-4); and grandstands, bleachers stadiums, and amusement park structures (A-5).
<b>Business</b>	Office buildings (group B) for business transactions of all kinds including banks, corporate offices, professional offices, government buildings, beauty shops, motor vehicle showrooms, and out-patient clinics.
<b>Educational</b>	Buildings for educational purposes through the 12th grade (group E).
<b>High Hazard</b>	Buildings used to manufacture, process, or store materials that constitute a high fire, explosion, or health hazard (group H).
<b>Hotels, Motels, Guest Houses</b>	Buildings for shelter and sleeping where the primary occupants use the facility on a temporary basis, staying less than 30 days (group R-1).
<b>Industrial</b>	Factory buildings where the occupants make, process, or assemble products that are not highly combustible, flammable, or explosive. Includes automotive, appliance, and furniture manufacturers; electric power plants; food processing plants; foundries; and water pumping, solid waste disposal, and incineration plants (group F).
<b>Institutional</b>	Buildings for people who suffer from physical limitations because of age or health; buildings for people detained for penal or correction purposes. Includes: supervised residential homes for six or more people (group I-1); medical and nursing-care facilities (I-2); jails, reformatories, and asylums (I-3); and day care for six or more occupants (I-4).
<b>Mercantile</b>	Buildings for display and sale purposes. Includes retail stores, automotive service stations, drug stores, shops, salesrooms, and markets (group M).
<b>Storage</b>	Buildings used to store goods that are not highly combustible or explosive. Includes warehouses, open parking garages, lumberyards, livestock shelters, and mausoleums (group S).

## Exhibit C

### Residential Structures (U.S. Census Bureau Definitions)

Tables 4, 5, and 6 show authorized housing units based on the structure types defined below by the U.S. Census Bureau. The number of units shown in these tables refers to those authorized by building permits issued for new construction only.

**Single-Family Houses**

Include all detached one-family houses and all attached one-family houses separated by a wall that extends from ground to roof with no common heating system or inter-structural public utilities. Include prefabricated, sectionalized, panelized, and modular homes that are manufactured partially off site, but are transported and assembled at the construction site.

**Two-Family Buildings**

Include all buildings with two housing units that may be above one another or side by side. If built side by side, the structures (1) do not have a wall that extends from ground to roof; or (2) share a heating system; or (3) have inter-structural public utilities, such as water supply and sewage disposal.

**Three- and Four-Family Buildings**

Include all buildings with three or four housing units. If built side by side, the structures (1) do not have a wall that extends from ground to roof; or (2) share a heating system; or (3) have inter-structural public utilities, such as water supply and sewage disposal.

**Five-or-More-Family Buildings**

Include all buildings with five or more housing units. If built side by side, the structures (1) do not have a wall that extends from ground to roof; or (2) share a heating system; or (3) have inter-structural public utilities, such as water supply and sewage disposal.

**Private Housing Units**

Housing owned by a private company or individual during the period of construction. This includes all housing built by nonprofit organizations and "turnkey" housing; for example, housing that will be sold to a local public housing authority when completed.

**Public Housing Units**

Housing owned by a governmental body during the period of construction.


