DRESSING ROOM REGULATIONS  
GOVERNING  
BAKERY AND CONFECTIONERY ESTABLISHMENTS

1. A dressing room shall be provided for each sex in every bakery and confectionery establishment.
2. Each employee must change from street clothes to working clothes in these hereinafter described dressing rooms and shall wear such working clothes only in the work shop; working clothes must be washable.
3. Dressing rooms shall conform to the following requirements;
  1. Dressing rooms shall be separated from the work-room, water closets, and toilet rooms, by adequate partitions but should be in near proximity to the latter and entirely enclosed.
  2. Dressing rooms shall be heated, lighted and ventilated and must be kept clean at all times.
  3. Adequate floor space shall be provided, the minimum dimensions being 3' x 4' for use of one or two persons up to four, and 3 sq. ft. for each additional person from five to nine. For ten or more employees 2 sq. ft. per person shall be added.
  4. All dressing rooms shall be provided with adequate clothes hanging facilities such as a pipe rail equipped with clothes hangers and installed at a sufficient height to prevent dragging.
4. Construction of dressing rooms shall conform to Division standards and be erected in a workman-like manner. Walls or partitions shall be solid and at least 8 ft. high and must be sealed over or extended to ceiling height.
