The region's total passenger traffic bounced back solidly from January's weather-related 2.9 percent fall with a 6.3 percent increase (+548,749 travelers) and a record 9.3 million passengers as both domestic and international traffic grew strongly. The domestic sector set the tempo with a 5.7 percent gain (+332,450 passengers) and a new record of 6.2 million passengers for the month of February. International traffic, too, set a new mark with 3.1 million travelers, driven by a robust 7.5 percent rise (+216,299 passengers). The cargo momentum accelerated in February as the region's total freight volume grew by a robust 11.7 percent (+18,422 tons). International cargo, which accounts for 64 percent of the region's total freight activity, was the main growth driver with an 11.5 percent leap (+11,626 tons). Domestic cargo expanded by 12.2 percent (+6,796 tons).
