16:25A-2.1 Standards for soil erosion and sediment control

(a) The Department of Transportation (Department) adopts and hereby incorporates by reference into this chapter as standards for soil erosion and sediment control, those standards originally promulgated by the Department in consultation with the State Soil Conservation Committee and the Department of Environmental Protection on July 18, 1988, and the revisions dated June 12, 2008. The standards are published in a manual entitled “Soil Erosion and Sediment Control Standards,” and are the technical basis for Department certification of soil erosion and sediment control plans for Department projects.
