# How to Become a NJ FamilyCare Community Doula Provider

All doulas serving NJ FamilyCare must enroll as fee-for-service providers and be prepared to serve fee-for-service members.

## Steps to Enroll

Step 1: Complete an Approved Community Doula Training Program

Step 2: Complete Supplemental Community Competency Training

Step 3: Become a Fee for Service Provider

Step 4: Contract with the Managed Care Organizations (MCOs) as a Community Doula Provider
