SEPTEMBER 1998

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Comparing counts for September 30, 1998 with those on September 30, 1997, the following changes are noted:

RESIDENTS

7% increase	from	27,648	to	29,580	for the jurisdictional population; (state inmates in county facilities, prison and youth complexes);
-32% decrease	from	4,460	to	3,018	for state inmates in county facilities;
19% increase	from	18,235	to	21,781	for the prison complex;
-3% decrease	from	4,953	to	4,781	for the youth facilities.

ADMISSIONS

-2% decrease	from	1,249	to	1,227	for total admissions.
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RELEASES

3% increase	from	1,090	to	1,126	for total releases;
-12% decrease	from	752	to	659	for male parole releases;
-13% decrease	from	88	to	77	for female parole releases;
-12% decrease	from	840	to	736	for total parole releases;
18% increase	from	250	to	295	for offenders discharged at max.

NOTES: DEFINITIONS OF INMATES INCLUDED IN COUNTS

- a/ **RESIDENTS** include inmates in the institutions and on furlough on the last day of the reporting period. Past counts for major institutions may include the count for units that are no longer open. Housing security levels are designated as follows: SL I-community, SL II-minimum, SL III-medium, SL IV-maximum and SL V-close.
- b/ **ADMISSIONS** include commitments, parole returns for technical violation and prison and correctional returns from escape entered into the OBCIS database each month.
- c/ **DISCHARGE AT MAX** includes adult offenders released upon expiration of maximum sentence. Juvenile offenders are not included in this count.

REPORTING OF JUVENILE RESIDENTS ADMISSIONS AND RELEASES DATA has been discontinued. All juvenile offenders became the responsibility of the Juvenile Justice Commission, Department of Law and Public Safety as of July 1, 1996.

NOTE: Commencing April 1998 County Contract/Assistance and County Waiting figures are merged and reported as State Inmates in County Facilities.
