**RESIDENTS, ADMISSIONS AND RELEASES
FEBRUARY 1996**

Comparing counts for February 29, 1996 with those on February 28, 1995, the following changes are noted:

RESIDENTS

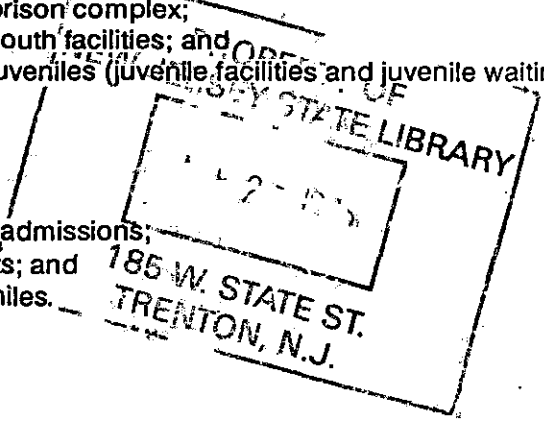
- 12% increase from 25,049 to 28,017 for all institutions;
- 11% increase from 24,393 to 27,187 for the adult jurisdictional population; (county waiting, county contract, county assistance, prison and youth complexes);
- 30% increase from 3,605 to 4,696 for county waiting;
- 8% increase from 960 to 1033 for county contract and county assistance;
- 7% increase from 14,778 to 15,867 for the prison complex;
- 11% increase from 5,050 to 5,591 for the youth facilities; and
- 27% increase from 656 to 830 for the juveniles (juvenile facilities and juvenile waiting).

ADMISSIONS

- 23% increase from 1,206 to 1,478 for total admissions;
- 21% increase from 1,130 to 1,364 for adults; and
- 50% increase from 76 to 114 for juveniles.

RELEASES

- 7% increase from 947 to 1,016 for total releases;
- -2% decrease from 659 to 649 for adult male parole releases;
- -4% decrease from 71 to 68 for adult female parole releases;
- -2% decrease from 730 to 717 for total adult parole releases;
- 31% increase from 196 to 257 for offenders discharged at max; and
- 100% increase from 21 to 42 for juvenile releases.



NOTES: DEFINITIONS OF INMATES INCLUDED IN COUNTS

- a/ RESIDENTS include inmates in the institutions and on furlough on the last day of the reporting period. Past counts for major institutions may include the count for units that are no longer open. Housing security levels are designated as follows: SL I - community, SL II - minimum, SL III - medium, SL IV - maximum and SL V - close.
- b/ ADMISSIONS include commitments, parole returns for technical violation and prison and correctional returns from escape entered into the OBCIS database each month.
- c/ DISCHARGE AT MAX includes adult offenders released upon expiration of maximum sentence. Juvenile offenders are not included in this count.
