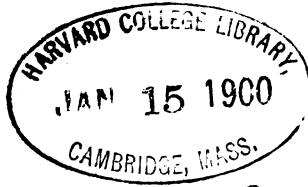

## Report of the State Librarian.

*Hon. Foster M. Voorhees, Governor :*

DEAR SIR—In accordance with the act of 1878, which requires a full and complete statement of the condition of the State Library to be made by the Librarian to the Legislature, the following report is submitted:

By the last annual report of the State Librarian it was shown that the number of books, pamphlets, magazines and newspapers in the Library was 51,270. There have been added during the portion of the past fiscal year covered by this report, by purchase, exchange and donation, 1,688, as follows :

This would make the total number of books, pamphlets and papers in the Library at the end of the year, 52,958; but in October, by direction of the Library Commissioners, there were returned to the Superintendent of Documents, at Washington, 787 duplicate books and pamphlets that had accumulated, leaving the actual number 52,171. These duplicates were useless to the State Library, but were wanted at Washington to supply the needs of other libraries. In return the Superintendent of Documents will endeavor to supply volumes needed to complete the State's sets of Government publications.

The increase shown by this report is about 600 less than last year, due largely to the fact that the report for 1898 contained the accessions made up to January 1st, 1899, while this ends with October

31st. The Appendix will show in detail the additions made to the Library during the period named.

The number of books reported, 52,171, while approximately correct, is not really so, as there has been no inventory made for many years, and, under the system practiced of freely loaning books to be taken from the Library, many have been lost. During the last year the Library Commissioners adopted a rule forbidding the loaning of books from the Library to be taken from the Capitol. The necessity for this was because of complaints from lawyers from various parts of the State who visited Trenton to consult books known to be in the Library, only to find that their journeys were useless because the books had been borrowed.

The last printed catalogue of the books in the Library was made in 1853. In 1862 a new catalogue was prepared, but never printed. Since then the only sources of information concerning the books have been the written catalogues, kept in the Law and General Libraries, and the annual reports of the Librarians. The written catalogues soon become so defaced by corrections and interlineations as to be of little use excepting to the assistants who make the entries and changes. To make a new printed catalogue would cost several thousand dollars and consume years of time, and after it had been printed it would be inaccurate by reason of the additions made during the period of time required for the printing. The card catalogue system is being adopted by libraries generally as the best method of keeping a record of the contents of a library. It consists of a series of cards containing the titles of the books and the names of their authors, arranged alphabetically. There are several schemes in operation in connection with the system, all of which have champions, but the simplest seems to be that known as a "dictionary catalogue." To introduce the system would require the expenditure of \$4,000 or \$5,000, and a year or so of time, the length of time depending on the number of persons engaged in the work of classification and writing the cards.

The limited experience of the present Librarian makes him difficult about recommending the introduction of a new system, particularly as it will be much easier to work along under the crude system now in operation; but it appears to be a matter of duty for him to bring the subject to the attention of the Legislature. If the system is to be changed, the sooner it is done the better, as the yearly increase in the number of books will make the work more difficult, and there is apparently no escape from the change in the near future. Nearly all of the work in connection with the change could be

done by the present Library force, but for the reason that it would be prolonged beyond a reasonable time because of other demands upon them. After a better scheme of classification and cataloguing has been adopted the basis will be laid for indexing which will render available a wealth of historical interest contained in some of the old volumes.

Of the \$3,000 appropriated annually for the purchase and care of books, about \$1,800 was spent during the past year for the purchase of law books and law magazines, about \$875 for books, magazines and newspapers for the General Library, and the remainder for binding and repairing. About three-fourths of the amount paid for law books, or \$1,316, was for "continuations," to keep up the series of reports, digests and magazines already in the Law Library, and a little less than \$500 for law text books. Of the \$875 spent in the General Library, about \$250 went for "continuations" of books, magazines and newspapers to keep up the sets, and about \$625 for miscellaneous books having value as works of reference or dealing with New Jersey State or local history.

Some books and pamphlets having considerable historical value have been published at the expense of the State, copies of which have reached the State Library only by purchase, and some are still missing. There are also annual reports of State organizations which are valuable, copies of which are occasionally received. Papers read before various societies, conventions and public gatherings often contain facts and figures concerning local and State history that are of great value, but in few cases printed copies reach the State Library save by purchase or accident. An effort has been made to secure the co-operation of those concerned in order that the Library may be benefited, and reference is made to the fact here in order that the aid of others may be enlisted, and a copy of every printed book or pamphlet having historical reference to the affairs of the State or any of its municipalities or people, or having genealogical value, may find its way into the State Library. The interest in genealogy has been greatly increased in recent years by the formation of patriotic organizations, and many demands are made on the Library for books on the subject.

During the Summer considerable progress was made on the work of cataloguing the New Jersey books, pamphlets and newspapers in the General Library, which will soon be finished, and many of the pamphlets classified and bound into volumes. The work was discontinued by reason of the demands of the Traveling Library system about to be operated.

At its meeting in June the Library Commissioners appointed a committee to prepare a plan upon which to establish the Traveling Libraries, and at a meeting in October the plan was adopted. Since the appropriation made by the Legislature at its last session did not become available until November 1st, but little could be done beyond the preliminary work of preparing the necessary blanks and circulars and selecting books for purchase. The blanks and circulars were sent out on November 1st to over thirty persons who had applied for information. At this time it is not possible to make any report on the libraries, but if it is desirable a supplemental report will be made early in January, in order that the Legislature may be informed of the progress of the enterprise.

The plan as adopted by the Library Commissioners follows :

“ The small traveling libraries to be created by the Board of Commissioners of the State Library, under Chapter 175 of the Laws of 1898 (p. 415), shall be designated as ‘New Jersey Traveling Libraries,’ and shall bear a number, the first being numbered one. Twenty libraries, or as many as may be purchased and operated with the appropriation of \$1,500 made in 1899, shall be provided. Each shall contain not more than fifty volumes, made up of standard and contemporary fiction, biography, history, travel, and works on science, literature and other subjects. Not more than fifty per cent. of the books in any of the libraries shall consist of fiction, and at least one-half of them shall be such as are likely to be read by young persons.

“ The books shall be selected and purchased by a committee of the Commissioners of the State Library, or under the direction of such committee. They shall be put into small book cases, for which outer traveling cases shall be provided. These cases, together with suitable printed catalogues, rules governing the operation of the traveling library system, and the necessary blanks, instructions and other needed appliances, shall also be procured under the direction of the committee.

“ The books shall be numbered on the back of covers, and also on the inside, and each shall contain a book plate on the inside front cover, bearing the following : ‘New Jersey Traveling Library No. —’; also the number and cost of the volume, and any other information thought to be necessary.

“ The traveling libraries shall be operated from the State Library, and shall be loaned to the residents of such localities as shall apply for them, preference being first given to such municipalities as may be considered too small to maintain a public library, and secondly to those municipalities which shall first make application.

“ All the expense for making up and delivering the traveling libraries to the railroad station or express office nearest their destination, and also for returning the same to the State Library, shall be paid from the traveling library fund, but a charge of five dollars a year will be made to cover

the cost of transportation, if any, and all other charges. This must be paid in advance by the trustee hereinafter provided for to the State Librarian.

“Traveling libraries will be sent to a community upon the application of twenty resident taxpayers, who must select a trustee and a librarian, who will become responsible for the proper usage and safe return of the books.

“The books are to be loaned without charge to any resident of the locality over 14 years of age who will sign an agreement to pay promptly any fines imposed for over-detention of books, or for unreasonable injury to a book while in his possession. Children under 14 years of age may have the privileges of the libraries when their agreements are endorsed by the trustee; the object of the traveling library system being to furnish good books to as many readers as possible.

“All losses or injuries to books, beyond reasonable wear, must be promptly adjusted. The expense for rent (if any), light and fuel for the room in which a traveling library is located must be borne by the residents; but to aid in defraying this expense a fine of one cent a day may be levied on borrowers who retain a book for more than two weeks without renewal.

“In case of loss or unreasonable damage to books, the advantages of the traveling library system shall be denied to a community until payment has been made therefor to the State Librarian; and since the Trustee of the traveling library has become responsible therefor, the local librarian may refuse to lend books to a borrower who refuses to pay for the cost of a book lost or damaged while in his possession.

“The library shall be kept in a place convenient for the residents of the locality, and shall be kept open not less than one hour on each of two days in each week.

“A traveling library may be kept in one locality not more than six months, when it shall be returned to the State Library, and another will be sent to replace it.

“Any moneys received by the State Librarian to pay for the loss of or damage to books, or from applicants for traveling libraries, shall be used by him to replace the books lost or damaged, and any balance remaining at the close of the fiscal year shall be turned over to the State Treasurer.”

Among other books which the State Librarian is required by law to place in the Library are twenty bound copies of the Legislative Documents. In recent years these have made one hundred bulky volumes, and they are rapidly filling the shelves in the attic of the Library and encroaching on the space needed for the documents received in exchange from other States. The bound volumes of the New Jersey newspapers that are preserved are also outgrowing the space allotted to them and some new arrangement must soon be made for their care. At least three new cases will soon be needed for the books in the Law and General Libraries.

Under the act of March 29th, 1878, the Secretary of State was authorized to insure the State Library against fire, in the sum of not exceeding \$15,000. At that time the number of volumes in the Library was between 20,000 and 23,000, a portion of which was fiction. At a low estimate the 52,000 volumes now in the Library are worth \$125,000. In case of their loss by fire many of them could not be replaced at any price. Under the circumstances it may be considered desirable that the amount of the insurance should be increased.

The more important additions made to the Library during the year have been Mews' Digest of English Case Law, 16 volumes; the Lawyers' Reports Annotated, 44 volumes; and Law Reports, Ireland, 38 volumes, to complete the set in the Library.

The supply of the earlier printed volumes of the New Jersey Archives has been exhausted and it is no longer possible to supply full sets of them. No copies remain of the first six volumes, and but few copies of volumes 7, 8, 9 and 10.

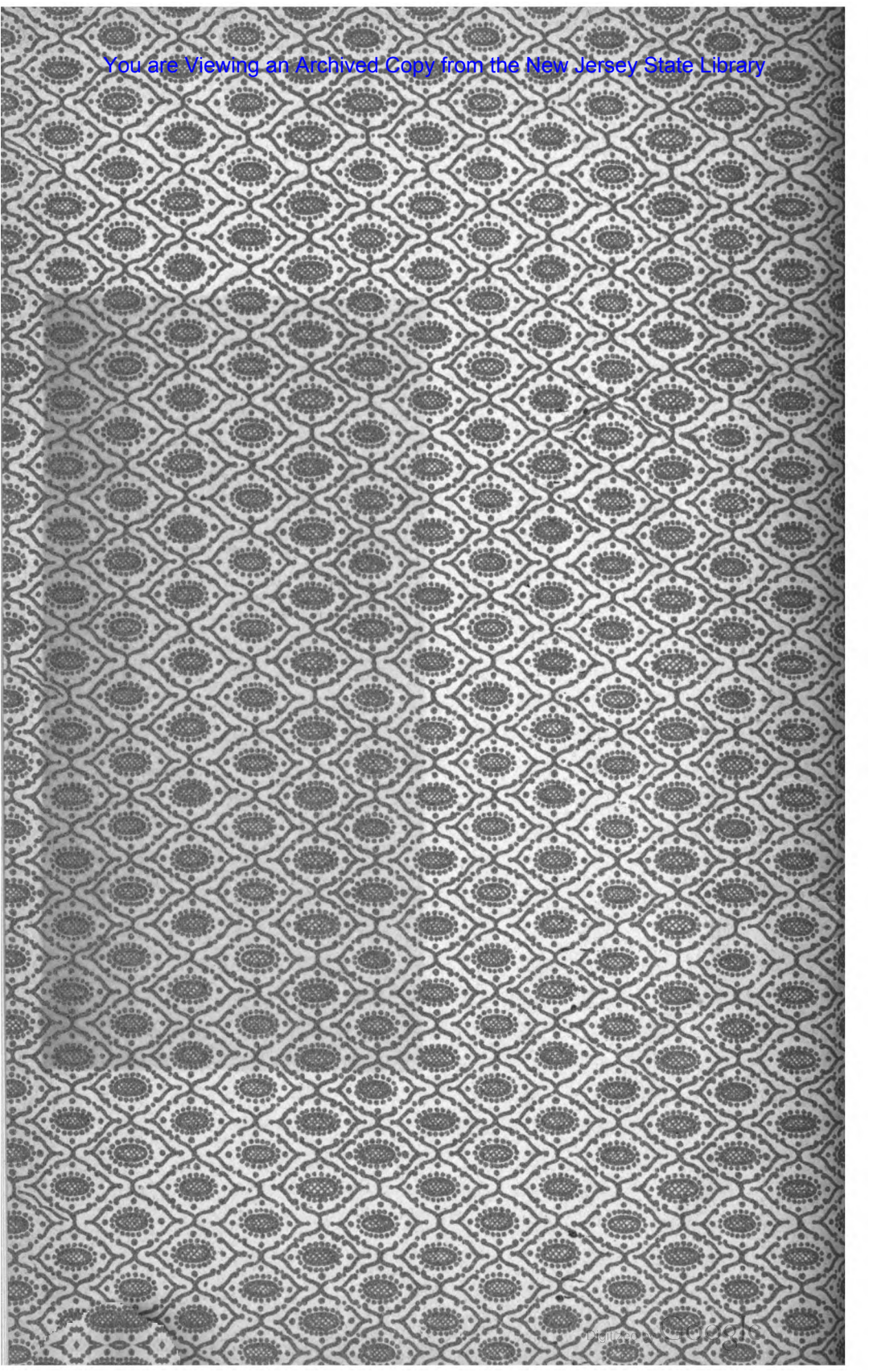
