A UNIQUE SERVICE FOR NEW JERSEY INDUSTRY

Pursuant to the Governor's Executive Order # 57 the Office of Business Advocacy staff to the Commissioner of Labor & Industry is charged with the responsibility of implementing a program of Permit Coordination on a state and local level. OBA provides assistance in guiding the applicant through the permit maze. OBA's technical staff function as expeditors in resolving the unexpected problems encountered when constructing a project.

The Office of Business Advocacy will designate a Permit Expediter to your project. The Permit Expediter will:

- A. Advise you of what DEP permits are required for your project, upon completing "MASTER PERMIT INFORMATION APPLICATION APPLICATION FORM".
- B. Coordinate contacts with relevant local and state regulatory agencies upon request.
- C. Monitor the progress of your permit application.
- D. Act to ensure processing of most permits within 90 days of application.
- E. Process "Over The Counter" certain permits meeting appropriate criteria.

## OVER-THE-COUNTER PERMITS

### I. STREAM ENCROACHMENT (609) - 292 - 4869

DEP now has a one-day processing service for certain minor stream encroachment permits. This "over-the-counter" service is limited to minor projects which do not adversely change the water carrying capacity of the floodway, do not increase erosion or sedimentation in the stream, and do not require substantial channel modification or relocation. For further information contact the Bureau of Flood Plain Management, P.O. Box CN029, Trenton, NJ 08625.

### II. RIPARIAN (609) - 292 - 2613

DEP has a one-day processing service for minor Riparian projects. This over-the-counter service applies to waterfront construction activity in man-made lagoons and minor maintenance and/or repair or replacement of lawful existing structures. For further information contact Riparian Lands Management, P.O. Box 1889, Trenton, NJ 08625.

### III. SEWER EXTENSIONS (609) - 292 - 3846

DEP has a one-day processing service for "minor" sewer extension projects. Eligible projects must meet certain criteria, such as length of 1000 linear feet or less, cost of \$25,000 or less, sewage flow per day of 12,000 gallons or less. No projects with pump stations, force mains, siphons, gallonage transfers or holding tanks will be processed over-the-counter. Projects can not be located in areas under sewer ban, administrative orders, or litigation.

Projects must be in-house by 9:30 a.m., and all administrative documents must be in proper order. Pre-application conferences are strongly recommended. For further information contact Division of Water Resources, P.O. Box CN029, Trenton, NJ 08625.

## MASTER PERMIT INFORMATION APPLICATION

DEP has developed a Master Permit Information Application which, upon completion, will indicate all the DEP permits required for the project. Forms may be obtained by contacting the Office of Business Advocacy (See inside cover for details).

STANDARD APPLICATION FORM (CP #1)

Effective July 1, 1979

The Department of Environmental Protection has been implementing a new "standard application form" for permits on construction related projects. The new application form replaces more than twenty different forms previously used, and should enable DEP to provide the public with more efficient and timely service.

The Standard Application Form has been designed, in the spirit of "Executive Order #57," through the efforts of the "Governor's Cabinet Committee on Permit Coordination" to simplify permit application forms and processing procedures. Eventually DEP plans to use one application form and one permit form for all of its Divisions.

In order to assist applicants through the permit maze, DEP began implementing the CP #1 application on July 1 for the Division of Water Resources and the Division of Coastal Resources.

The CP #1 form is available in a booklet which includes for specific permits the following information: legal citations, contact phone numbers, lists of requirements for "complete applications", endorsements, and general background information on permitting.

Applicants will use this one form for the general information of their projects, but some highly technical permits will require technical addenda forms.

## THE COMMISSIONER

### Proposed Amendments Concerning 90 Day Construction Permits

Betty Wilson, Acting Commissioner of Environmental Protection, pursuant to authority of N.J.S.A. 13:1D-33, proposes to adopt amendments concerning 90 day construction permits.

The proposal involves the deletion of the current text of N.J.A.C. 7:1C-1.10, Other state statutes, rules and regulations, 7:1C-1.11, Severability, and 7:1C-1.12, Implementation of these rules and regulations; the recodification of the current text of N.J.A.C. 7:1C-1.9, Appeals, which will now be cited as N.J.A.C. 7:1C-1.10; and the adoption of new rules concerning over-the-counter processing which will be cited as N.J.A.C. 7:1C-1.9, if adopted.

Full text of the proposed new rules follows:

#### 7:1C-1.9 Over-the-counter processing

(a) As a means of expediting permit review for certain minor projects, the Department will fast process, unless emergencies dictate otherwise, minor projects in the categories of stream encroachments, sewer extensions and riparian waterfront development.

(b) Stream encroachment rules are:

1. The Department will provide a 24 hour, one day processing service for certain "minor" stream encroachment permits (listed below). Projects must be in-house by 9:30 A.M., otherwise the permit will be put in the mail, or can be picked up the next day. Pre-application conferences are recommended to ensure that all necessary material will be submitted. An appointment must be made for the over-the-counter submittal process, review, and permit issuance.

2. The Construction Permit form (CP #1) must be properly completed, but it does not need to be forwarded to any county or municipal agency (See N.J.A.C. 7:1C-1.3(c)). An engineering data sheet must be completed for all stream encroachment projects. For headwalls, under the stream encroachment application engineering data sheet, only the following items need be supplied: a, b, c, d, e, f (one plan view and one profile of the out-flow line continuing so as to include a cross-section of the channel), h, j, l, and t. Note: there is a separate data sheet for Pipelines/Cables.

3. Minor stream encroachment projects are projects which do not adversely change the water carrying capacity of the floodway, do not increase erosion or sedimentation in the stream and do not require substantial channel modification or relocation.

1. Minor stream encroachment projects which will be processed on an "over-the-counter" basis shall include, but are not limited to:

- (1) Sewer headwalls;
- (2) Outlet works;
- (3) Sewer outlet diffusers;
- (4) Minor water intake facilities;
- (5) Minor regrading;
- (6) Utilities that are constructed within 100 feet of the top on the channel bank;
- (7) Each channel crossing of utility;
- (8) Minor bank re-establishment and/or protection projects, limited to 100 feet;
- (9) Bridge deck replacements;
- (10) Farming practices (including ditches) approved by the Soil Conservation Service;
- (11) Projects whose major purpose is mosquito control pursuant to N.J.S.A. 26-9-1 et seq.

ii. Minor stream encroachment projects which will not be processed on an "over-the-counter" basis shall include:

- (1) Desnagging and stream cleaning;
- (2) Minor dredging projects;

- (3) Dug ponds without structures;
- (4) Channel excavations project, where all material is removed from the flood plain, or graded and stabilized;
- (5) Residential foot-bridges;
- (6) Recreation and habitat management structures of the Division of Fish, Game and Shellfisheries;
- (7) No "over-stream" crossing approval unless "attached" to the downstream side of an existing bridge or culvert and above the underclearance, or "Within" the superstructure of the bridge or culvert;
- (8) Combined projects of government agencies submitted as one minor project for a calendar year will not be considered as a minor project for "over-the-counter" permit purposes.

(c) Sewer extensions rules are:

1. DEP has a (24 hour) one-day processing service for "minor" sewer extension projects. "Minor" sewer extension projects must be:

- i. Length of 1,000 linear feet or less;
- ii. Cost of \$25,000 or less;
- iii. Sewage flow per day of 12,000 gallons or less.

2. No projects with pump stations, force mains, siphons, gallonage transfers or holding tanks will be processed over-the-counter. Projects cannot be located in areas under sewer ban, administrative orders, or litigation.

3. Projects must be in-house by 9:30 A.M., and all administrative documents must be in proper order. Pre-application conferences are strongly recommended. Over-the-counter projects will be processed by appointment only.

4. Applicants must include in the application package proof of a prior approval, endorsement, or a letter of no objection from all required local agencies prior to filing application with the State.

5. An "engineer's report" form, available from the Public Wastewater Facilities Element of the Division of Water Resources, must be completed and certified by a licensed New Jersey engineer and subfitted with the application.

(d) Riparian rules are:

1. DEP has a (24 hour) one-day processing service for "minor" Riparian projects. This over-the-counter service applies to waterfront construction activity in man-made lagoons and minor maintenance and/or repair or replacement of lawful existing structures, so long as applicants submit the required information (including a prior riparian conveyance: grant, lease, license, from the State).

2. No over-the-counter authorization will be given for dredging, filling, or addition or changes in configuration of structures.

3. A pre-application conference is recommended. And in order to avoid unnecessary inconvenience, it is suggested that an applicant phone for an appointment on an over-the-counter project.

4. As a condition of approval, the applicant must give a forty-eight (48) hour notice prior to commencing work.

5. An applicant should apply for a same day permit by 11:30 A.M., otherwise his permit can be picked up the next day or mailed.

Aug. 22--DEP DENIES MOBILE HOME PARK'S CAFRA PERMIT--An application for a Coastal Area Facility Review Act (CAFRA) permit for a proposed 158-unit mobile home park on 18 acres beside Ocean Heights Avenue in Egg Harbor Township (Atlantic County) was denied by DEP because density of septic systems would pollute groundwater.

Notice Concerning Routine Implementation of the New Jersey  
Coastal Management Program - Bay and Ocean Shore Segment

On April 5, 1979, the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) adopted amendments to the Rules and Regulations under the Coastal Area Facility Review Act (N.J.A.C. 7:7D-2.1 et seq.). The rules were proposed on November 9, 1978 and were adopted following notice, public hearing, and public comment pursuant to the Administrative Procedure Act. They were procedural in nature.

Pursuant to Title 15, Section 923.84 of the Code of Federal Regulations, notice is hereby given that DEP regards this action as routine implementation of the New Jersey Coastal Management Program - Bay and Ocean Shore Segment. Section 923.84 defines routine implementation as any action which does not result in substantial changes to enforceable policies or authorities related to:

- (1) Boundaries;
- (2) Uses subject to the management program;
- (3) Criteria or procedures for designating or managing areas of particular concern or areas for preservation or restoration; and
- (4) Consideration of the national interest involved in the planning for and in the siting of facilities necessary to meet requirements which are other than local in nature.

The amendments to the CAFRA procedural rules clarified the procedures for requesting a CAFRA exemption request and extended by 60 days the time in which an exemption request could be filed (the exemption period has now expired), and amended the environmental impact statement requirements for housing projects to conform with the statutory requirements of CAFRA (N.J.S.A. 13:19-1 et seq.). In addition, a minor change to the pre-application conference process was made.

DEP has asked that the Federal Office of Coastal Zone Management concur in its determination that this action is routine in nature. Person wishing to comment on this determination may do so in writing to the person indicated below within 3 weeks of the date of this notice.
