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Notes1: The section entitled Air Transport Association Carriers is included to give a comparison between Port Authority Airport traffic growth and aggregate growth as measured by the majority of the U.S. carrier industry.

Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized. "Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

8.5 million passengers used our airports. Although our monthly growth expectation was low due to Thanksgiving occurring at the end of November pushing holiday travel into early December, the traffic nevertheless was up 1.2%. In contrast to our region, the nation's traffic, as reported by A4A, dropped 1.9%. Even though carriers collectively decreased seat capacity by 1%, the increase in passenger levels proved that airlines matched flight frequencies and demand better at our facilities. From the start of the year, 66.5 million domestic and 36.3 million international passengers used our airports for a total of 102.8 million, exceeding pre-recession levels. Region's cargo decreased 2.3%, with domestic down 14.7% and international up solid 5.4%. While fundamentals of cargo business remain weak, international sector growth could be a catalyst for improvement in our region
