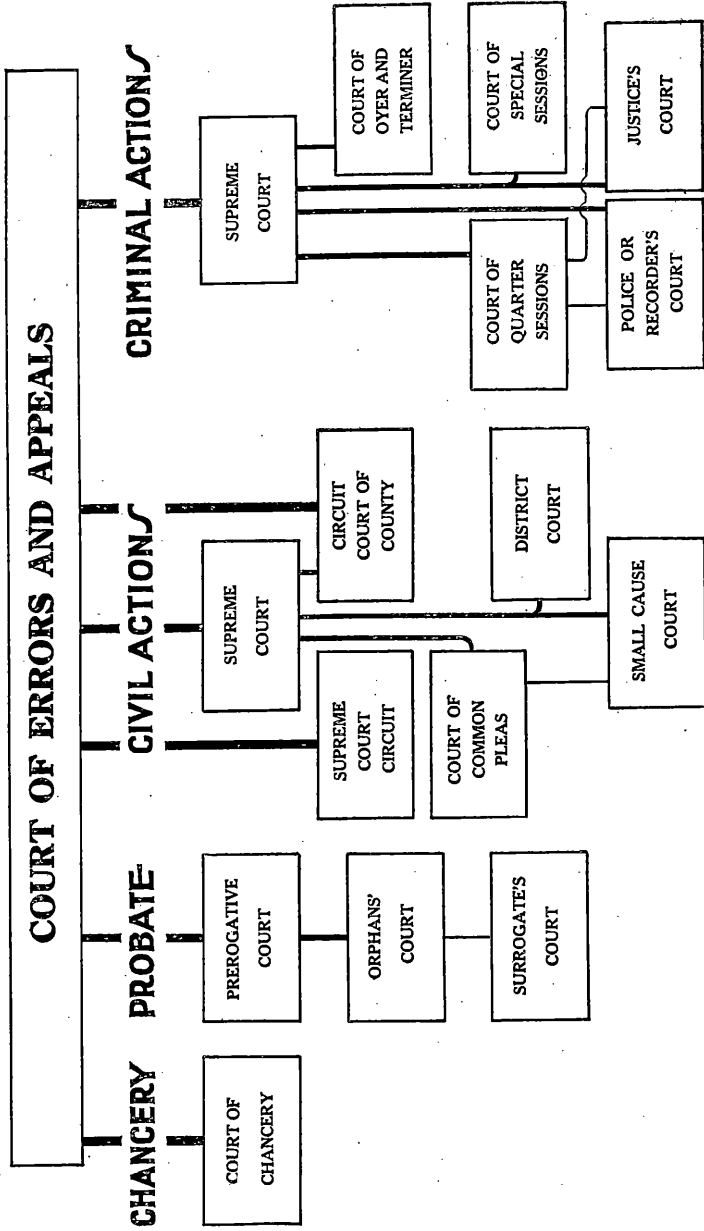

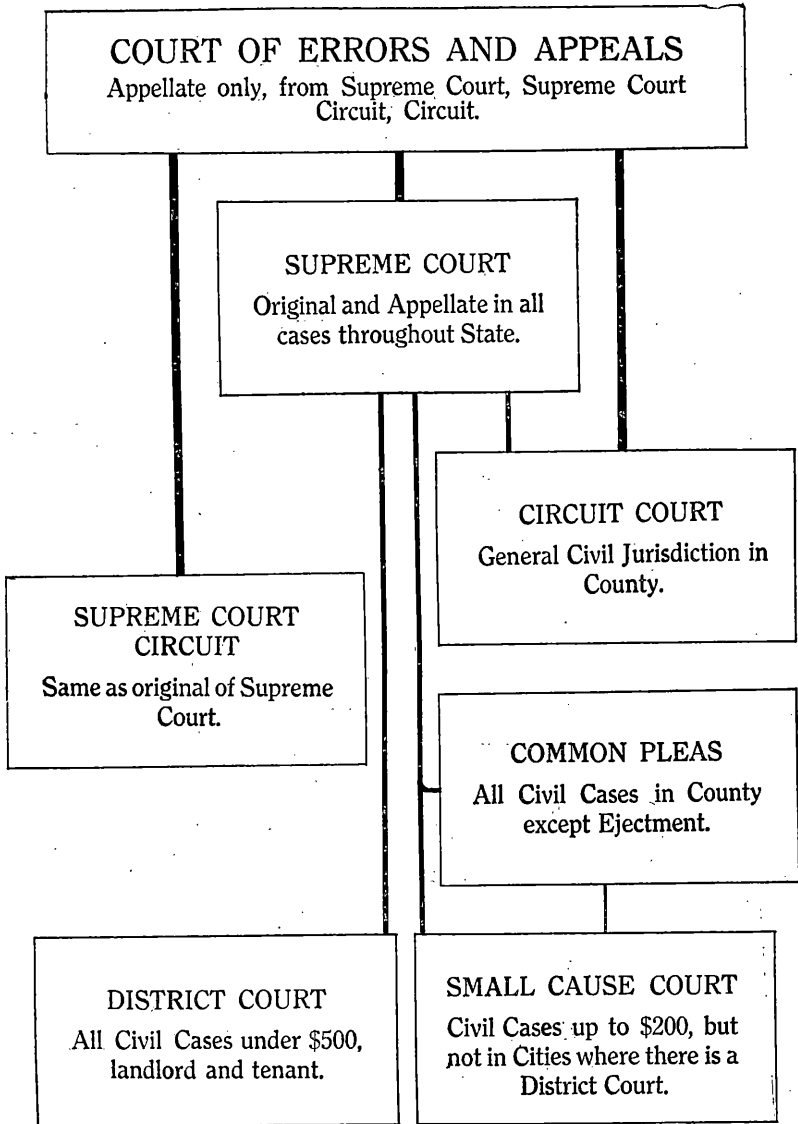

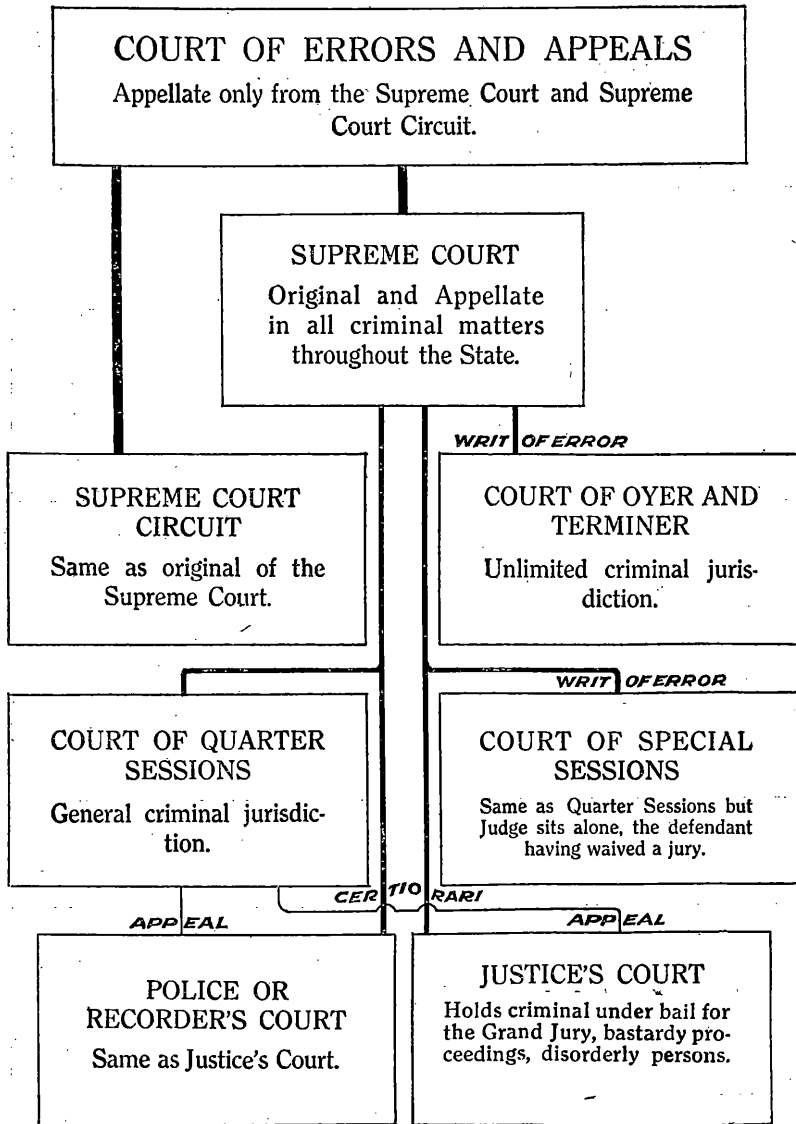

JURISDICTION IN MATTERS OF PROBATE IN NEW JERSEY

COURT OF ERRORS AND APPEALS
Appellate only from the Prerogative Court

PREROGATIVE COURT (the Ordinary)
Same original jurisdiction as the Orphans' Court and Surrogate's Court; also hears appeals from these Courts. The Chancellor is the ordinary, the Vice-Chancellors, vice-ordinaries.

ORPHANS' COURT (Judge of the Court of Common Pleas)
Determines controversies as to existence and validity of wills, right to administer, accounts of executors and administrators, appointment of guardians. Audits accounts of these.

SURROGATE'S COURT (The Surrogate)
Admits will to probate where there is nothing wrong on the face of it, and no caveat is filed, issues letters testamentary, audits accounts of administrators, executors, etc.
