PLEASE NOTE: All rates shown are rates for the purchase of small employer coverage in the state-regulated small employer market. Each carrier listed has filed its rates with the Department of Banking and Insurance and each carrier has also certified that its rates conform with applicable laws and regulations. The rates listed here may not be the most current rates in effect. Rates may be guaranteed for a specific period of time. Ask the carriers for their current rates and details concerning rate guarantees.

As of January 2014, the **Small Employer Health Benefits Program (SEH Program)** defines a small employer as an employer with at least one but not more than 50 employees.
